



· Answered: 375 Skipped: 0


Responses ranked highest to lowest:




















Scores Received:


Staff Survey Results

Food Service: 0%


Comments/Trends: 30.99% of respondents work at Perry High School. If respondents chose OTHER, they were asked to comment as to why. Here is what 4 people commented:


Comments/Trends: 39.44% of the staff at Perry Local Schools feel they effectively communicate its value to the community.

Responses ranked highest to lowest:


















