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General Information

Founded in 1999, Renaissance Academy (RA) is an award-winning, tuition-free, independent charter school. The high school curriculum is college-preparatory, designed to encourage students to think objectively and to approach life thoughtfully and creatively. The US News & World Report ranked RA #16 out of ALL Pennsylvania public high schools and #1 PA Charter School on their 2023 Best High Schools list. Nationally, the report ranked RA #641 out of the 18,000 public high schools reviewed and assessed.

Community

The school is located in Phoenixville, Pennsylvania approximately 20 miles from Philadelphia. RA educates over 1,100 K-12 students from more than 22 different school districts, creating a diverse student population. Of the students in grades 9-12, 40.47% participate in the National School Lunch Program.

The objective of this project is to provide the graduating seniors of Renaissance Academy with an authentic learning experience outside the classroom where they will find the opportunity to think critically and communicate effectively. Each project is initiated by a personal interest, supported by self-directed research, and resulting in a uniquely formulated presentation.
