

Upcoming, Balm Entrance & AGB

General Updates, Recent & Upcoming Maintenance Events

Yellowstone to develop a mowing and detail map with sections to be serviced by week.

There were fertilization events for beds, palms and turf.

Vendors, please refer to the item # in your responses listing action already taken or anticipated time of completion. Black indicates **Yellowstone** Landscaping. Red text indicates a landscaping deficient item from previous report. Bold Red text indicates a landscaping item deficient for more than a month. Green text indicates a requested proposal. Blue indicates Ballenger & Co. Irrigation.

- 1. At the Balm entrance, remove the old Annual Flowers and prep beds for new rotation.
- 2. At the Balm entrance monument, the replacement Podocarpus have been replaced. They look healthy. (Pic 2)



- In the south ROW of Balm, prune all plant material contacting the fencing and restake tipped trees.
- 4. At the Balm entrance islands, new plants have been installed near the water features.
- In the median island just south of the Balm entrance, there is a dead Ornamental Grass unit. Remove and treat the nearby Ornamental Grasses.

- 6. In the west ROW of AGB, remove several dead branches that are hung up in the mature Live Oaks.
- 7. In the beds along AGB, the weeds have been sprayed. Remove all dead material & detail them. (Pic 7)



- 8. Yellowstone to have all cutbacks on any overgrowing natural areas that are encroaching on maintained areas and pond banks scheduled and/or completed by the end of April.
- 9. Along all of AGB, remove all vines in the beds, on the hedge and on the wall.
- 10. In the same area, diagnose and treat the Viburnum hedge as they have webbing.

11. At the Stonegate entrance island, remove all Witches Broom from the Ornamental Grasses. (Pic 11)




12. Clear out under brush and line trim this area and all other similar areas. (Pic 12)



- 13. At the corner of the courts, remove the Ligustrum stump.
- 14. Remove all tall grasses in the Viburnum hedge by hand pulling.
- 15. Remove all stumps and root balls from trees tipped in the hurricanes.
- 16. Along AGB, diagnose and treat the stressed and thinning Viburnum hedges.
- 17. Property-wide, treat all active ant mounds.

- 18. Along AGB, there are areas of turf that are chlorotic and thinning. Correct.
- 19. In the north ROW of AGB between Haddon Mist & Barley Field, remove weeds from beds along the wall. (Pic 19)



- 20. Property-wide, remove all suckers from the Live Oaks & Magnolias.
- 21. All natural areas throughout the property, including those near 11036 Standing Stone are encroaching and need to be pushed back several feet. Please provide a plan of action to take care of this.
- 22. At the Highland Courte entrance in both ROWs & median, detail the beds including weeding.
- 23. Remove all dead plant units at all neighborhood entrances.
- 24. The recently installed Viburnum along AGB, are still struggling and dying. Correct this.
- 25. Along the AGB, during the pruning rotations prune Viburnum to achieve an even elevation & let them gain height in a controlled manner.
- 26. Property-wide, remove any dead Sago palms and develop possible replacement strategies, including bed to turf ratios.



AGB, 301 Entrance, Haddon Mist & Sumner

27. In the north ROW of AGB at the 301 entrance, schedule a rotation to prune the Ornamental Grasses and remove the strapping from the Crape Myrtles. (Pic 27)



- 28. At the 301 entrance, hold off on installing any new plants until the accident damage is repaired.
- 29. In the south ROW of AGB at the 301 entrance on the back side of the pond, remove all plant material contacting the fencing.
- 30. At the Highland Chase entrance, weed all beds.
- 31. On Haddon Mist behind the Amenities Center, there is a medium sized Live Oak that tipped over in the storm and should be removed.
- 32. In the south corner of Crescent Rock & Haddon Mist and along Haddon Mist, Crescent Rock & Carloway Hills, there are trees that need to be staked. Any that will not recover, remove. (Pic 32 >)
- 33. At all common areas on Carloway Hills & Crescent Rock, detail the tree rings, with weeding and setting strong bed lines. In some areas, the tree rings are non-existent.
- 34. Property-wide, treat all joint crack weeds.

- 35. Diagnose & treat the Magnolias along Crescent Rock between 14619 & 14716 Crescent Rock. They are thinning and have continuous leaf drops.
- 36. Please, mow ponds on a regular schedule and keep mowing the taller grasses that have been missed by the previous vendor, especially along natural areas.
- 37. In the common areas in the north ROWs of Carloway Hills & Crescent Rock, there are declining/dead Magnolias & Live Oaks. They are by the sidewalk in a turf area and the others are at the mail kiosks. Diagnose and treat. Re-stake any trees that have been tipped over in the high winds.
- 38. At the maintained area between Sumner & Kelly Green, mow & trim back overgrowing plant material.
- 39. Major turf issues along Sumner Rd, at the Stonepark monument and entrance, and along Misty Moss. These areas have been infested with chinch bugs & have never been treated. There is some improvement. Treat the weeds.
- 40. In the new phase, remove all tree stakes, remove strapping/re-strap as necessary & create tree rings.

41. In the new phase schedule maintenance rotations for the dry season to cut back all overgrowing plant material encroaching on maintained areas.
42.At Kelly Greene & Sumner in the outbound ROW by the mail kiosk, remove all suckers from the Ornamental Trees.
43. In the same area, hard prune the Loropetalum to improve line of sight for the signage.
44. There was construction/maintenance at the Amenities Center so there was no inspection. I will monitor this area on a later visit.
