A well-written paragraph has a topic sentence, 3-4 supporting facts or details from the text, and a closing sentence.

Writing Assignment - Why would Norton Juster choose a boy like Milo to be the hero of the novel? Please respond in a three paragraph essay. A well-written paragraph has a topic sentence, 3-4 supporting facts or details from the text, and a closing sentence.

Entering 7th Grade:

The Voyage of the Dawn Treader by C.S. Lewis (ISBN: 978-0064405027)

Writing Assignment - Based on what we know of Eustace in the book, how does one become a dragon? What can be learned from Eustace's character and choices that would inevitably lead to becoming monstrous? Write a one page essay that includes specific quotes and examples from the text.

Entering 8th Grade:

Animal Farm by George Orwell (ISBN: 9780451526342)

Writing Assignment - Near the end of the story, The Seven Commandments are reduced to one single Commandment: 'All Animals are equal but some are more equal than others.' Write a one-page essay reflecting on what this change means and what it is communicating to the Animals of Animal Farm.
