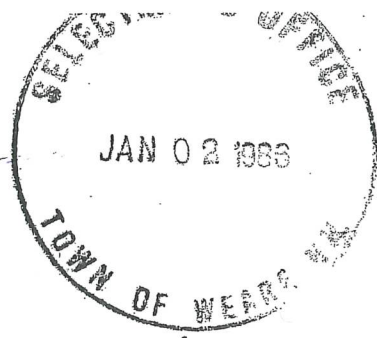




JOHN STARK REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOND VOTE



December 18, 1985
New England College Field House

Prior to the start of the meeting Moderator William Damour swore in Mary-Beth Lally as clerk of the John Stark Regional School District.

Moderator William Damour brought the meeting to order at 7:15p.m.

His first order of business was the reading of the Bond motion:

"I move that the district raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,750,000 for the construction of the John Stark Regional High School including furnishings and equipment, architectural and other fees, site acquisition, site development, and other items incidental to and necessary for such construction and to raise said sum by the issuance and sale of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Revised Statutes Annotated of New Hampshire, as amended. The terms and place of payment of interest, rates of interest, provisions for the sale of notes or bonds and all other matters in connection therewith, to be left to the discretion of the School Board."

He then informed everyone that this meeting was being tape recorded.

Frank Farmer moved to accept the motion as read. Duly seconded.

Mr. Damour noted that ballot voting, for said Bond issue, would start after all questioning had ended, and remain open for 2 hours or until 11:00p.m., whichever came first.

He also noted that the Bond vote must pass with a 2/3 majority.

Moderator Damour opened the meeting for discussion or questions. Questions were answered from the floor.

Moderator Damour moved to commence voting at 9:05p.m. Duly seconded.

The voters checklists, from both Henniker and Weare, were used and supervisors were present in the balloting.

At 11:05p.m. Moderator Damour announced that balloting was closed.

Mr. Damour announced the result of the vote:

757 yes
316 no

Of the 7000 ballots printed, 1,073 were cast. No motion was made to reconsider the vote. The motion to adopt the Bond was declared by Moderator Damour to have been adopted in the affirmative, receiving the 2/3 majority required to pass. On a motion by Mr. Damour, duly seconded, the meeting adjourned at 11:20p.m.

At this meeting Peggy Hatfield was sworn in as Treasurer of the John Stark Regional School District by William Hatfield, Justice of the Peace.
