

The Watford City Parks and Recreation Foundation Scholarship Program

The Watford City Parks and Recreation Foundation offers scholarships for eligible Watford City Park District employees and children of eligible Watford City Park District employees who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school. Priority is given to a recreation/leisure/natural resource/sport/turf/park management curriculum as a major area of study.

All resident McKenzie County students are eligible to apply. The scholarship must be utilized by the school year term and is a one-time award per individual.

Scholarship

The Watford City Parks and Recreation Foundation will award monetary scholarships for the academic year to qualified individuals.

Eligibility Criteria

- High school senior, enrolled full-time freshman, sophomore or junior college student that plan on enrolling full time at a North Dakota 2 or 4-year college/university
- Preference will be given to Watford City Park District employees and children of eligible Watford City Park District employees. (6-month good standing employment)
- Secondary preference will be given to current McKenzie County student residents
- Enroll in Recreation/leisure/natural resource/sport/turf/park management curriculum as a major area of study
- Community involvement
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent.
