PROPOSAL OVERVIEW:

The Clubhouse Manager is responsible for the overall operation, administration, and customer service functions of the community clubhouse and amenity facilities. This position ensures that residents and guests receive exceptional service while maintaining a safe, clean, and welcoming environment. The Clubhouse Manager oversees facility operations, amenity staff, resident programs, rentals, events, and vendor coordination while serving as the primary point of contact for residents utilizing the amenities.

- Maintain strong working relationships with residents, Board members, and management staff.

Event Management

- Manage clubhouse rental reservations, contracts, deposits, and event logistics.
- Plan, coordinate, and execute community events, activities, and resident engagement programs.
- Monitor event budgets and ensure successful execution of programs.

Administrative Responsibilities

- Maintain accurate records of facility reservations, incidents, maintenance requests, and resident communications.
- Prepare reports regarding clubhouse usage, events, and operational activities to present monthly to the Board.
- Assist with amenity related budget preparation and monitor amenity related expenses.
- Ensure compliance with community policies, procedures, and operational standards.
- Manage amenity calendars and communication platforms.,

Vendor & Contract Management

- Coordinate services provided by vendors, contractors, and service providers.
- Monitor vendor performance and ensure contractual obligations are met.
- Obtain quotes, as directed, and assist with vendor selection for amenity-related services and projects.

- Respond appropriately to emergencies and incident situations.

Observations:

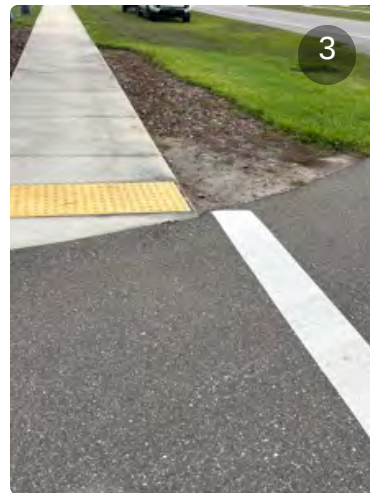
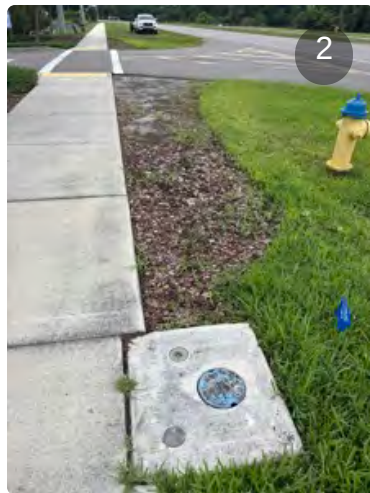
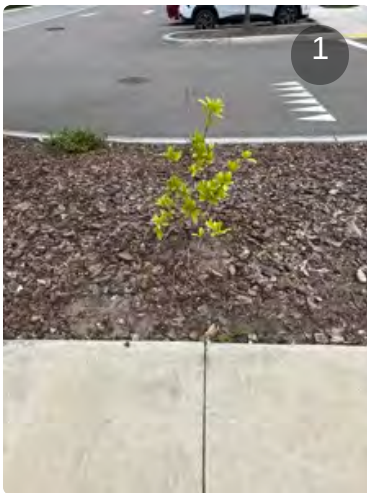
Gardenia shrub is declining and showing poor health.

Previously an annual bed area located in front of the sidewalk is empty.

Recommendations:

Remove and replace declining Gardenia as needed to restore landscape appearance.

Sod in the bed area in front of the sidewalk to create a more uniform presentation.



Issue 2

Pool Deck Area

Observations:

Photos 1 and 2 document raised pavers adjacent to the pool slide area.

Photos 3 and 4 document an additional section of raised pavers along the pool deck.

Photos 5 and 6 show pavers with sharp edges that may present a safety concern.

Photo 7 documents a sinking paver located beneath the handrail area.

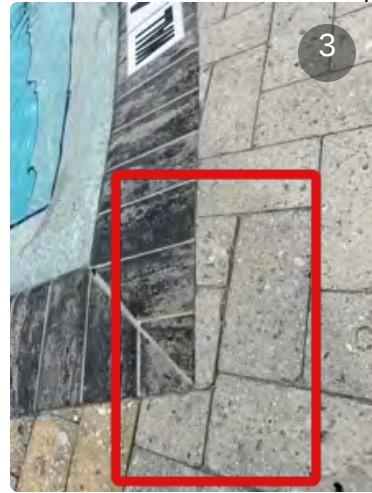
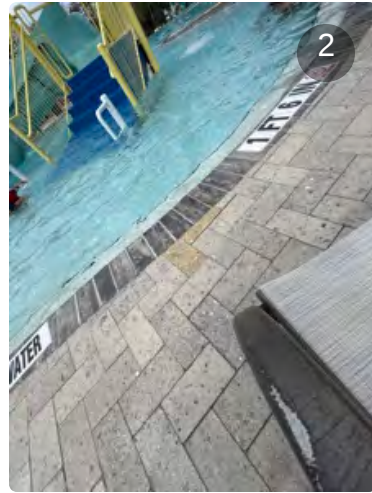
Recommendations:

Inspect and repair raised pavers to eliminate trip hazards and restore an even walking surface.

Repair or replace pavers with sharp edges to improve safety around the pool deck.

Reset and stabilize sinking paver beneath the rail to prevent further settlement and potential hazards.

Continue routine inspections of the pool deck for additional paver movement or deterioration.



Issue 3

Riverview / Still Creek Dr

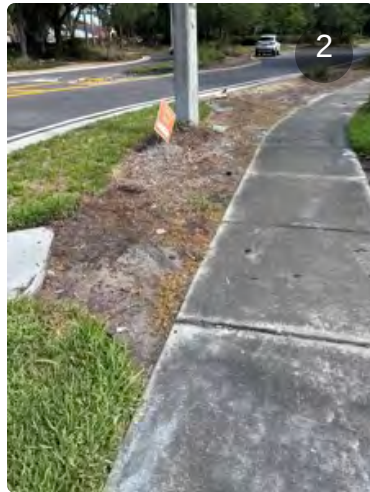
Observations:

Utility box hazard on Riverview has been replaced and corrected.
Empty bed area on the inbound side of Still Creek.

Recommendations:

Recommend filling the empty bed area on the inbound side of Still River with sod to improve appearance and provide uniform coverage.

Evaluate irrigation coverage prior to sod installation to support establishment.



Issue 4

Assigned To: LMP

Towne Lake Rd – Near Castle Creek Dr

Observations:

Pine tree limbs are hanging low over the sidewalk.

Recommendations:

Lift/prune pine tree limbs along the sidewalk to restore clearance.

Continue routine tree maintenance and monitoring to prevent future encroachment.

Issue 5

Assigned To: Inframark Maintenance/ Onsite

Ladies Restroom

Observations:

Sink on the right side is loose and requires adjustment.

Recommendations:

Tighten and secure sink to ensure proper stability and functionality.



Issue 5

Falkenburg Rd – Across from the Amenity Center

Observations:

Utility/marketing flags are present near the sidewalk. The purpose and status of the markings are currently unknown.

Issue 5

Assigned To: LMP

Harvest Glen – Southbound Right Side

Observations:

Dead shrub present and in need of removal.

Jasmine plantings appear wilted and stressed.

Ornamental grasses are very dry and showing signs of decline.

Recommendations:

Remove dead shrub to improve landscape appearance and prevent further deterioration. Evaluate irrigation coverage and plant health conditions contributing to the wilted Jasmine and dry grasses; replace plant material as needed.

Remove and/or treat Brazilian pepper tree to prevent the spread of invasive vegetation. Continue monitoring the area for additional landscape health concerns and irrigation deficiencies.



Issue 8

Assigned To: Plumber/District Manager

Amenity Center – Men's Restroom

Observations:

Toilet flush mechanism requires adjustment to ensure proper operation.

Recommendations:

Inspect and adjust the flush mechanism to restore proper functionality.

Fence needs power washing and trimmed behind @ 8608 white poplar drive



Issue 10

Assigned To: Field/District Manager

Still Creek Dr – Sidewalk Safety Concern

Observations

Sidewalk panels along Still Creek Dr are raised and uneven behind 8307 Moccasin Trail Dr and 8311 Moccasin Trail Dr.

The elevation changes create a potential tripping hazard for pedestrians.

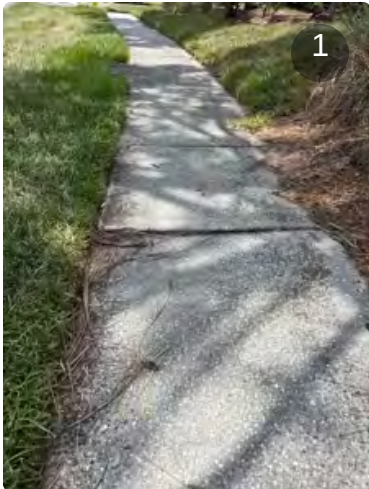
Recommendations

Inspect the affected sidewalk sections to determine the extent of uplift and identify the cause.

Repair, grind, or replace the raised sidewalk panels as needed to restore a safe and even walking surface.

Service Request CN0577869 has been created for sidewalk repairs.

Continue monitoring adjacent sidewalk sections for additional movement or trip hazards.





Issue 11

Assigned To: LMP

Hamlet Median

Observations:

Weeds are present throughout the median landscape area. The median is in need of general detailing and cleanup to restore its appearance.

Recommendations:

Treat and remove weeds within the median landscape beds. Perform detailed maintenance, including edging, trimming, debris removal, and bed cleanup, to improve overall presentation.

Continue routine monitoring and maintenance to prevent weed regrowth and maintain landscape standards.



Issue 12

Assigned To: LMP

Sanctuary Area

Observations:

Copperleaf plantings outside the Sanctuary are wilted and showing signs of stress.

Recommendations:

Evaluate irrigation coverage and soil moisture levels to determine the cause of the wilting.

Monitor plant health and provide corrective measures as needed, including irrigation adjustments, fertilization, or replacement if recovery does not occur.

Continue routine monitoring to ensure the plantings return to healthy condition.

Issue 13

Assigned To: LMP

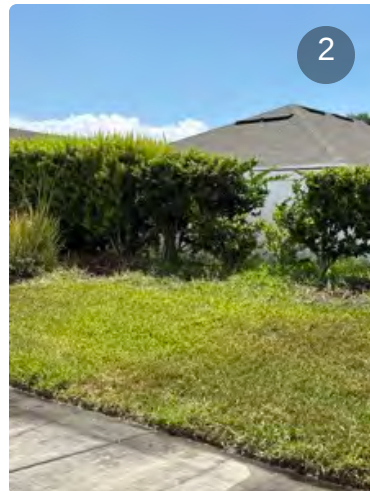
Falkenburg Rd – Berm Area Before Castle Creek (Southwest Bound)

Observations:

Weeds are present on the berm along Falkenburg Rd heading southwest before reaching Castle Creek.

Recommendations:

Treat and remove weeds from the berm to maintain a clean and well-maintained appearance. Continue routine monitoring and follow-up treatments as needed to prevent regrowth. Inspect surrounding landscape areas for additional weed pressure and address accordingly.



Issue 14

Assigned To: LMP/Field/District Manager

Still River Dr – Across from Amberley

Observations:

Sidewalk panels are raised, creating a potential trip hazard. Plantings in the area are declining and require removal.

Recommendations:

Inspect and repair/level raised sidewalk sections to restore a safe walking surface.

Remove dead or declining plantings to improve overall appearance.

Evaluate the area for possible replacement plant material and continue monitoring for additional maintenance needs.

Added additional sidewalks to previous Service Request CN0577869.



Issue 15

Assigned To: Board/District Manager

Pond 3 – Access Gate Issue

Observations:

Gate at Pond 3 is secured with locks on both sides of the pond.

Current access setup restricts aquatics and landscape vendors from completing a full circuit around the pond, requiring them to backtrack and re-enter from the opposite side.

This configuration reduces service efficiency and increases maintenance time.

Recommendations:

Evaluate gate access configuration and consider replacing existing chains and locks with a standardized lock system.

Provide a vendor-access code or approved key system to allow efficient, continuous access for routine maintenance.

Would the Board be open to a proposal to update the locking system to improve operational efficiency for both aquatics and landscape services?

Site Assessments

Pond# 1

Comments:

Pond 1 looks good overall.

Algae was previously targeted for treatment with positive results observed. Only trace amounts of algae remain. This will continue to be targeted for treatment. The native submersed Vallisneria grass is present along the perimeter areas of the pond. Once water level rise, algae growth in this area should be reduced. Duckweed growth mixed in with algae was also targeted for treatment with positive results. Minimal new growth was treated along the exposed sediment.



Pond #2

Comments:

Pond 2 looks good overall.

Torpedograss treatments in the currently dry area in front of the littoral shelf have taken place. Positive results can be seen and follow up treatments will be performed to target the remaining amount. Algae was previously treated with positive results and a reduction seen. The native submersed Vallisneria grass is present along the perimeter areas of the pond. Minimal new growth of shoreline weeds and invasive grasses were targeted along the exposed sediment.

Pond# 3

Comments:

Pond 3 looks good.

Recent treatments have targeted algae growth. A reduction and positive results were seen. Only a trace amount of algae remains. The remaining algae will continue to be targeted for treatment. Shoreline weeds and invasive grasses were targeted along the perimeter of the pond.



Pond #4

Comments:

Normal growth observed.

A minimal amount of algae growth was observed in the shallow area in front of the Cattail growth. This will be targeted for treatment during the upcoming visits. No other issues were observed with submersed weeds or shoreline weeds.

Pond# 5

Comments:

Pond 5 looks good.

Currently this pond is completely dry. While the pond is dry the exposed sediment will continue to be targeted for aquatic weed growth. Minimal new growth of aquatic weeds and invasive grasses were previously treated in this area. Some trash/debris was observed on this site.



Pond #6

Comments:

Normal growth observed.

A minimal amount of the submersed weed Chara was observed on this pond. This growth was limited to a few patches/spots around the shoreline perimeter. Treatments will continue to targeted this growth for a further reduction. Previous algae treatments have shown positive results with a reduction seen. Minimal amounts of aquatic weeds and invasive grasses were treated along the exposed sediment and shows positive results. The water level has remained low.

Pond# 7

Comments:

Pond 7 looks good.

Minimal aquatic weeds and invasive grasses along exposed sediment were recently treated and show positive results. No other issues were observed with submersed weeds or algae on this pond. The water level is currently low resulting in a few feet of exposed sediment.



Pond #8

Comments:

Pond 8 looks good overall.

The invasive growth in the littoral shelf area is being pushed back. Signs of previous treatment were observed. The exposed sediment was previously treated for Slender Spike Rush growth. Positive results were seen, and minimal remaining new growth was observed. The water level has remained low.



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Site Assessments

Pond# 9

Comments:

Pond 9 looks good overall.

Minor invasive grass growth was observed in the littoral shelf area. Signs of spot treatments were observed and some growth remains. Spot treatments will continue to targeted the remaining amount. The native plant species Bulrush was observed, growing in the littoral shelf area. This is a native plant and will provide benefits to the pond if it remains.



Pond #10

Comments:

Pond 10 looks good.

Currently this site is dry and not holding any water. Minimal amounts of invasive grasses and aquatic weeds were treated previously, with positive results seen. The patch of native vegetation, Arrowhead, is thriving despite dry conditions. No other issues to report about this site.

Site Assessments

Pond# 11

Comments:

Pond 11 looks good.

Previous treatments have targeted Planktonic algae growth and invasive grasses and weeds. Positive results have been seen from these treatments. An abundance of new pickerelweed growth was observed in several areas around the perimeter and will continue to promote this growth. Native bulrush growing around perimeter and in the littoral shelf area as well. This pond has remained very low with several feet of exposed sediment.



Pond #12

Comments:

Pond 12 looks good.

No issues were observed with algae, or submersed weeds on this site. Recently, a minimal amount of aquatic weeds and invasive grasses were treated around the shoreline perimeter. Positive results were seen from this treatment. A minimal amount of Primrose willow and invasive grasses were observed along the backside/wetland buffer side of the pond. The water level is at a normal level.

Pond# 13

Comments:

Pond 13 looks good overall. Signs of treatment were observed on the front edge of the littoral shelf. Around the perimeter of the pond Pennywort, Water Lettuce, and Azolla were all targeted for treatment with a reduction seen. Treatments will continue to target any new growth of this invasive vegetation. No other issues were observed, and the native submersed Vallisneria grass is present along the perimeter areas of the pond.



Pond #14 and #15

Comments:

Pond 14 & 15 looks good overall.

The perimeter area of these ponds were recently treated for invasive grass and aquatic weed growth with positive results seen. The finger section of Pond 15 were recent repairs on the bank were performed are currently undergoing treatments. A large portion of the invasive growth has already been targeted for treatment. The next several visits, this area will continue to be targeted for any new or remaining growth. No issues were observed with algae or submersed weed growth.

Comments:

Pond 16 looks good.

A very minimal amount of algae growth was recently treated on this pond. Positive results and a reduction were observed. The exposed sediment area around the perimeter was also recently treated for aquatic weeds and invasive grasses and positive results were seen. Some trash/debris was seen.



Pond #17

Comments:

Pond 17 looks good.

This pond was previously treated along the exposed sediment for a minimal amount of aquatic weeds and invasive grasses. Positive results were seen from this treatment. No issues were observed with algae or submersed weeds. The water level is at a low level. No other issues to report.

Comments:

Pond 23 looks good.

Very minimal amounts of invasive grasses or aquatic weeds were observed along the exposed sediment. Previous treatments have targeted this growth and positive results were seen. The water level is low with several feet of exposed sediment. No issues were observed with algae or submersed weeds. No other issues to report on this pond.



Pond #24

Comments:

Pond 24 looks good.

Currently this pond is nearly dry. This site was previously treated for minimal amounts of aquatic weeds, terrestrial weeds, and invasive grasses. Positive results were seen from this treatment and no issues were observed.
