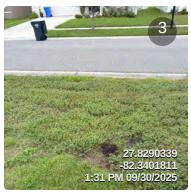
Crews need to be policing trash around the amenity center during every visit. Some of the trash I'm seeing appears to have been there for quite some time.

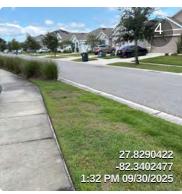

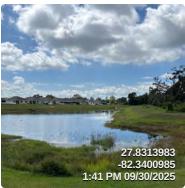

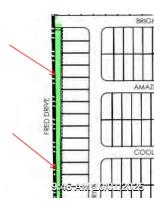

Item # 2 – Weeds on patio and pool deck

Weeds have been removed and sprayed – completed 9/2/25.

Pool area trimmed and vines removed on 9/2/25.

Item # 4 – Remove traveler seed in Fakahatchee grass behind pool – completed 9/2/25



Item #5 - Dead Bermuda grass behind pool -

Area looks to be recovering a little, smaller in size and some turf growth emerging. Continue to monitor the area for recovery.



Item# 6 – Pull weeds and vines from Ferm behind clubhouse:

Completed on 9/2/25 – Vines and weeds removed as well as trimmed the shrubs.

#7 – Ferns – struggling and sun scorched.

Discussed with the crew to not trim so that we can monitor new growth and reduce the stress on the ferns. Keep ferns trimmed off of sidewalks but allow them to grow taller and fill in. Ferns prefer shade or little direct sunlight. Irrigation is operating and consistent rain should allow ferns to fill in.

9 – Cap off drip lines in empty landscape bed- investigate standing water and algae in parking lot.

The irrigation technician will be out Thursday the 4th to check on the area to make sure there is no irrigation leak and see if he can determine where the water is originating from.

11 - Penta on corner of Tucker Jones - Continue to trim and remove any dead branches or plants in the Penta beds to encourage new growth/ flowering. – Ongoing service item.

#12- Lift mower deck on corner of Tucker Jones - Scalping

Discussed with the crew to change direction of mowing in this area in addition to making sure the mower deck is raised. 9/2/25

13 – West end of Tucker Jones – weeds overgrown

Crew was addressing the weeds on the west end on 9/2/25. Pulling and spraying, crew needs to continue each visit to address these weeds and trim the plants

14 - Trim suckers off of Oaks - Dog Park - completed 9/2/25





15 – Mowing of full pond – Completed on 9/2/25
