3rd Grade Report Card Information Sheet

The Odyssey Charter Schools Report Card is standard based and designed to communicate with parents and students the progress and learning being demonstrated in class for the current trimester. Students are evaluated on various categories within English-Language Arts, Math, Science, and History-Social Studies. For detailed information on specific standards, you are encouraged to look at PowerSchool. The report card also offers information on your child’s socio-emotional wellbeing and work/study habits. The sections below present more detailed information about the various content areas evaluated on this report card.

Grading Scale

The grading scale used in this report card focuses on the students progress toward mastery of a standard for the trimester. The standards are based on a year-long goal, and expectations may change from one trimester to the next. The grading scale models the achievement levels found on the CA Assessment Student Progress and Performance (CAASPP) which are the statewide assessments students take in grades third through eighth. The definitions of each are:

- /-- Standard not evaluated- This standard has not been covered in the present term.
- 1-- Standard Not Met- The student has not met the achievement standard and needs **significant** improvement to demonstrate the knowledge and skills required at this level.
- 2-- Standard Nearly Met- The student has nearly met the achievement standard and needs **some** improvement to demonstrate the knowledge and skills required at this level.
- 3-- Standard Met- The student has met the achievement standard and demonstrates the knowledge and skills required at this level.
- 4-- Standard Exceeded- The student has exceeded the achievement standard and demonstrates **advanced** knowledge and skill toward mastery of standards at this level.

Fountas & Pinnell Reading Level is determined through the use of Fountas & Pinnell Reading Benchmark Assessment System. This reading assessment is administered to determine a student’s ‘just right’ reading level. The reading benchmarks for 3rd grade are:

English Language Arts & Literacy Standards consists of four areas- reading, writing, speaking & listening, and language.

Mathematics Standards The Mathematics standards found on this report card originated from the CA Common Core State Standards. The standards are aligned with the Eureka Math curriculum.

- **Operations & Algebraic Thinking**- Student will represent and solve problems involving multiplication and division; understand properties of multiplication and the relationship between multiplication and division; multiply and divide within 100; solve problems involving the four operations, and identify and explain patterns in arithmetic
- **Numbers & Operations: Base Ten**- Student will use place value understanding and properties of operations to perform multi-digit arithmetic
- **Numbers & Operations: Fractions**- Student will develop understanding of fractions as numbers
- **Measurement & Data**- Student will solve problems involving measurement and estimation of intervals of time, liquid volumes, and masses of objects; represent and interpret data; understand concepts of area and relate area to multiplication and to addition; recognize perimeter as an attribute of plane figures and distinguish between linear and area measures
- **Geometry**- Student will reason with shapes and their attributes

Science Standards- The Science standards found on this report card broadly capture the critical skills and abilities students need in order to demonstrate mastery of the specific grade level standards. These standards originated from the Next Generation Science Standards and are taught in a developmentally appropriate manner which allows students to experience science in an experiential way.

History & Social Science Standards- The History & Social Science standards inform of students' learning along main standards of the particular grade level. These standards were derived from the CA History Social Science Standards and Framework. These standards are taught and evaluated using a variety of approaches in a developmentally appropriate manner.

Student Skills & Habits- Across the grade levels, these Student Skills & Habits have been selected by teachers to provide parents information about the important habits and skills students need to be successful as students.

Social Emotional Wellbeing- Student's social emotional wellbeing and development are derived from this component of our charter petition and highlight the skills students develop as students at Odyssey.
