Evening Social Procedures

These are the procedures for all of our evening socials. Students,

- Each social is for <u>Emerson</u> students only. Any student who brings an unauthorized "guest" will be excluded from the next event.
- •Students must be in school in order to participate in an evening social. The only exception would be part-day absence for an appointment.
- •Student dress for socials must be appropriate for school, which means that students must be decently covered from shoulder to mid-thigh. Cover-up sweaters are a good idea with some tops. For the Halloween social, costumes are encouraged.
- •Our socials are considered lock-in events. Once you are inside the school, you may not leave until the event ends at 9:00 p.m. Violation of this rule will result in exclusion from the next social. If you need to leave early, a parent or guardian must come into the multipurpose room to pick you up.
- •Entrance into the school is between 7:00 and 7:15 p.m. Between 7:15 and 7:30 p.m., you must have a parent or guardian accompany you to the entrance doors. After 7:30 p.m., students are not permitted to enter the social unless special arrangements have been made prior to the event with Dr. Mogil or Mr. Benka.
- Although we recognize that it is easy for students to wait since they use cell phones, transportation arrangements to and from the social should be made prior to the event. <u>Student safety dictates that youngsters not be forced to wait for rides</u>.
- •We ask that parents be prompt in picking up their child. Because we may have upwards of 300 students attending the social, we suggest that you agree on a pickup location prior to the evening. Parents may use the parking lot or Greendale Avenue on the east side of the school.
- •Socials are a lot of fun! Those staff members and parents who will be chaperoning look forward to students' good behavior and a great evening.
