


#### WHY DID WE ESTABLISH THIS COMMITTEE?

The Diversity Committee came to be, in part, because of our large EL (English Learner) population at Field School. This year 92 students qualified for EL services.



We celebrate the uniqueness of each individual by fostering confidence, empathy, awareness, and respect within our Field Family, and the larger global community.





This gives us a chance to share with Mrs. Schaab about our day, things that are going well and things that we might want help with or not good news.




## Gianna

XBlock has really transformed my teaching in a few different ways this year. I know my kids are getting extra instructional work time and I'm able to meet individual students' needs without having to worry about "how am I going to fit this in". My students who receive other special services, such as speech, instructional resource support minutes, social work, literacy, etc. aren't missing core instruction.
