Subject: Electrical Contractor for Carpenter School

At the December 19, 2011 Board of Education meeting the Board approved the District to begin design on mechanical upgrades at Carpenter School. Due to the large scope of work being proposed at Carpenter School and at the request of the District architects, we asked the Board of Education to phase the upgrades over a two-year time frame.

The District is asking for approval of Phase One. This will include an electrical upgrade consisting of relocating the transformer and running a new electrical service into Carpenter School. In order to accommodate the requirements needed to air condition the building in Phase Two, the District will be increasing the service to 1200 Amp from 600 Amp service.

The District received and opened one bid on April 24, 2012. After reviewing the bid and completing a scope of work review with Block Electric Company, Inc. of Niles, Illinois, the Facility Management Department and Fanning Howey are confident in recommending Block Electric Company as the contractor for the electrical upgrades.

While the District received only one bid for the electrical upgrades, Fanning Howey has checked the references of Block Electric Company and their bid was under probable cost estimated by Fanning Howey. Attached are comments and a list of current projects that Block Electric Company is working on. According to Illinois State Code the District can legally accept a single bid.

I contacted a few of the references that Block Electric Company, Inc. had submitted with their Bid. Summaries of our phone conversations are below:

1. Paul Neff, Account Executive with Pepper Construction Co. -

Paul had great things to say. He has worked on and off with Block Electric for the past 20 years, primarily on healthcare related projects. Re: Selection of Environmental Consultant

The *Illinois School Code* outlines the process a school district must go through if they wish to select an architect of record. When a district needs architectural, engineering or land surveying services, the contract must be awarded on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications. The district must advertise for (a) statements of interest and (b) statements of qualifications and performance data. The district must evaluate firms submitting these statements and select the top firms based on qualifications, ability of professional personnel, past record and experience, performance data on file, willingness to meet time and budget requirements, location, workload and other applicable factors. The top firms must be ranked in order of preference.

The school board must attempt to negotiate a satisfactory contract first with the top ranked firm and, if that fails, negotiate with other firms, in the order ranked. 50 ILCS 510/1 et seq; 105 ILCS 5/10-20.21.

The District legally advertised its interest in interviewing environmental consulting firms on March 8, 2012. On March 23, 2012, the District received seven (7) proposals from interested firms. The proposals were reviewed independently by Scott Mackall and Rebecca Allard. Two firms, Environ and Carnow Conibea and Associates, LTD. were selected to be interviewed on April 18, 2012.

On April 18, 2012 Mr. Mackall and Mrs. Allard interviewed both firms and determined Environ was the firm that best served the District needs.

Environ, as the current environmental consultant brings to the District:

- Environs' proven track record with regards to past projects
- School District client references
- Park Ridge based offices
- Wide range of services in addition to environmental services
- Longevity working with District 64

Recommendation:

The administration is requesting approval from the Board of Education to proceed in negotiating a new fee structure with Environ International Corporation.
