It has been a wonderful and positive first two days of school, and we look forward to welcoming our kindergarten students tomorrow! The PTO treated us to an assembly yesterday featuring The Stu Show. In addition to sharing his singing talents, the performer talked with the students about the importance of being kind, being positive and reading.

This year our Diversity Committee will continue our theme of, "Why Fit In When You Were Born to Stand Out?". Staff will also be focused on increasing growth in reading and math using even more differentiation strategies.

We are excited to welcome four new teachers to Field. Mrs. Balogi will be teaching third grade, Mrs. Fisher will be teaching English Language Learners, Miss Graham will be teaching fourth grade, and Mrs. Hurman will be teaching kindergarten. We also have two new PE teachers, Mr. Cacini and Ms. Pater. In addition, we have two new teaching assistants, Ms. Walsh and Mrs. Sugrue.

- Keeping your children safe is our top priority. Please help us by always coming
  directly to the office when you come to visit. We have a security system that
  requires all visitors to have their ID scanned. Please remember to bring your
  driver's license when you come to visit Field.
- We will be having Safety Week September 12th- September 16th. . During this week, we will practice what to do in case of fire, tornado, bus evacuation or a need to lock down the building.
- We appreciate your help at arrival and dismissal times. Please honor the "Kiss and Go" areas and do not allow your children to walk through the staff parking lot. Students can arrive at Field **after** 8:35. We do not have supervision before this time.

- If your child takes the bus, please carefully read the transportation information that was sent to you from the district office. Some stops have changed for this year. The bus drivers are not allowed to adjust routes or stops. All routes and stops are developed at the district level. Please do not talk to the drivers about adjusting the routes or stops because it can cause the buses to run behind.
- You should have received a link to our district handbook. Please remember to go over it with your child and complete the acknowledgment online.
- Please don't forget to make arrangements for our early dismissals on Wednesdays. Children should be picked up at 11:15am for morning kindergarten, and 2:40 p.m. for all other students.
- Our first PTO meeting this year will take place on Tuesday, September 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm in the LRC. I hope to see many of you there. We are so fortunate to have such an involved PTO, and we look forward to all of the events this school year.
- Many thanks to the PTO for our new playground equipment and to the district for the new painting! The students have been excited and eager to use it.
- We will be doing some beginning of the year assessments, starting with AIMS Web testing Monday for kindergarten and first grade students. MAP testing will be the week of August 29th for students in second, third, fourth and fifth grades. Students in these grades will take two MAP tests- one in reading and one in math.

Please help us in encouraging your children to demonstrate Field CARES. All students in first-fifth grades have now learned/reviewed how Field CARES looks in classrooms, in the hallways, at assemblies, on the playground, and in the lunchroom. Our kindergarten students will begin to learn about Field CARES when they officially start school. We will continue to reinforce these expectations throughout the year.


#### Parking/Driving

- · 3-center of building, Elmore
- · 4-center of building, Wisner
- 5-northwest corner, Wisner

#### **Playground Rules**


