The Park Ridge Police Department and District 64 Traffic Safety Committee have partnered to raise bicycle safety awareness once again. The first step to riding safely is wearing a helmet. Children are 14 times more likely to survive a bike crash if he or she is wearing a helmet. Studies show that wearing a bicycle helmet can reduce the risk of head injury by 85% and the risk of brain injury by 88% in bicycle accidents.

The contest is open to students in Grades K-3. Three winners per grade level will be chosen. Entries may be returned to school or dropped off at the Park Ridge Police Department, 200 S, Vine Ave. by *Thursday, April 13th 2017*. Winning entries will be announced Thursday, April 20, 2017 and displayed in the Park Ridge Police Department Lobby.
