

Printing With A Chromebook

Be sure that the Printer is set up for Wireless Printing

For information on how to set up Wireless Printing, please look up your printer's model and check documentation from the printer's brand (Dell, Epson, etc.)

1. On the bottom right-hand of the screen, right-click (or click) on the time.
2. Click on the "Settings" option (it is the cog).
3. At the bottom of the screen click on "Advanced" or in the search bar, type "Printing".
4. Click on the printers option.
5. In "Available printers to save", find your printer and select "Save".
6. Under "Saved Printers" make sure your printer is there.

Taking Pictures With a Chromebook

1. In the bottom left-hand side of the Chromebook, click on "Launcher".
2. From Launcher, look for the "Camera" app.
3. Three options will appear when you click on Camera:
 - a. Photo → Take Photo
 - b. Video → Start Recording
 - c. Square → Take Photo

To find your photos At the bottom right-handed corner of the camera, click on the thumbnail of the last picture that was taken. Clicking on the file will enlarge that file.

Deleting photos or videos Click on the "Delete" button/trash can
