This system for barricade will be complete including teacher training before school starts.

**PRESCHOOL SPECIAL NOTE:** While parents are not required to purchase lunches from the school for their children, WCS is required by the policies set forth by the State of Oregon Child Care Division to ensure that children are served meals that meet USDA standards. These guidelines have been illustrated in the USDA's diagram of **MY PLATE:** 



A summarized explanation of **MY PLATE** is found in these simple rules:

- Half my plate should be made up of fresh fruits and veggies
- Half my plate should be made up of grains and proteins
- At least half of the grains on my plate should be whole grains
- The proteins on my plate should be lean and not loaded with sodium
- Dairy products should represent the smallest portion on my plate

### F.I.R.S.T. Events

### Service Opportunities

At WCS we recognize that every person has a unique set of talents and gifts. We want to help you determine what those are and where they best fit. We also understand that you are busy, so we want to work with you to discover the best volunteer opportunity for you. We have service opportunities on a daily, weekly, monthly and yearly schedule. No experience is necessary! Some parents focus on one or two major activities, while others do lots of little projects all year long. Service hours can be completed through working on WCS's monthly or annual events, helping in your student's classroom, assisting in athletics, etc. *Our goal is for each family at WCS to complete 20 hours of service per year.* 

### How Do I Get Involved in Serving?

At WCS, the safety of our students is critical to us. In order to ensure that safety, we require all volunteers to:

- Complete and turn in the Volunteer Application Form which includes 3 references and information for background check.
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• **If you have a child in Pre-K**, complete the Application for Enrollment in the Child Care Division's Central Background Registry and cover the cost of the \$3.00 processing fee. It is available online at <u>www.childcareinoregon.org</u> and the fee may be paid with a credit or debit card at that site.

If you are willing to be a driver for field trips:

- Request your three-year Non-Employee Driving Record from the Department of Motor Vehicles. Please have them fax it to us @ 541-686-8747. You may apply for this in person at the DMV. The DMV charges a fee of \$1.50. Please bring your receipt to the school office so that it can be tracked if the fax is not received.
- Complete and turn in the Transportation Form.
- Bring a copy of your current Auto Insurance Card to the school office.

### What Happens Next?

- Once these documents have been completed and returned to the school, the application will be reviewed and references will be verified.
- You will receive a call from the Office Staff, who will complete the application process, review your availability, discuss where you would most enjoy serving and answer any questions you may have. *Note: this process may take 2-3 weeks to complete.*
