- All Seniors are required to attend class on Tuesday, May 16th during periods 1 – 4.
- Seniors are **NOT** expected to attend PE class during their final exam period.
- Students may leave **AFTER** they have completed **ALL** of their final exams for the day. However, they must provide their own transportation.
- Finals for seniors in mixed grade level classes will be held in the **ARENA**. Finals for seniors in **SENIORS ONLY** classes will be held in their **CLASSROOM**. Please confirm with your teacher if your final exam will be in the Arena or your regular classroom.
- Students that took the AP test for the course are exempt from their final exam and will not attend class the day of the final. AP students who did not take the exam are expected to take a final exam during their class period.
- Students without an exam scheduled should report to the Café or the LRC (Quiet Study) while waiting for their next exam.
- Students may not leave and return to school, unless under SLO.
- If a makeup exam is needed, please make arrangements with your teacher.
- Commencement tickets will be distributed at practice on Friday, May 19, 2017. Practice is required for ALL students who plan to march. Seniors will be excused for the day at the conclusion of practice.

- Lunch/Transitions and study halls will not meet.
- Flex periods have been scheduled for students to balance exam schedules.
- All classes, where final exams are given, will meet for the entire exam period.
- When students finish their exam, they must stay in the classroom.
- A final assessment is required for all departments with the exception of Physical Education.
- The final assessment will be counted as 20% of the final grade.
- During the three days of exams, morning buses will pick up at the regular time.

Students only need to be present during their scheduled exam periods. Study hall, lunch, and Physical Education do not meet during final examinations. During those periods students may use the library or the café annex for quiet study. Once the students enter the library or cafeteria, they may not leave to go to lockers. The cafeteria will be used for snacks and study but will not be a quiet study area. **The cafeteria will not serve lunch on examination days.** Students are able to leave the building after their last exam, but they must provide their own transportation. However, they are not permitted to leave and return.

The flex periods, A, B, C, and D are designed for any student who may have three exams in one day. A student may arrange with a teacher to take one of the three exams during a flex time. It is the student’s responsibility to make arrangements with their teacher. Students are not permitted to take final exams prior to Monday, May 22, 2017. Students who miss an exam due to vacation will take it upon their return.
