

Freshmen, Sophomores and Juniors

These students will be participating in our annual District Assessment Day that will take place on **Tuesday, April 9, 2019**. These assessments focus on the knowledge and skills required for college and career readiness and are required by the Illinois State Board of Education.

Your student will be taking the SAT, PSAT 10 or the PSAT 8/9 on April 9, 2019. Below is important testing information:

- **All students MUST remember to bring their calculators, two #2 wooden pencils, testing admission ticket and photo ID to testing.**
- **Calculators – please make sure calculator is charged or student has extra batteries.**
- Students should arrive at school and report to their assigned locations **no later than 7:30 am.**
- Students will receive notification of their testing room location on **Monday, April 8, 2019.**
- Students will be released from school at approximately 12:30 pm
- Freshman will also be taking the Illinois Science Assessment and must bring a charged Chromebook and headphones.

Seniors

Because seniors are not involved in this testing, a variety of educational opportunities are available for them on this day.

Seniors may choose from the following options:

- Pre-arranged tour/visit at the College of Lake County.

- Pre-arranged off-campus job shadowing.
- Pre-arranged day of service.
- Pre-arranged off-campus college visits.
- Tech Campus: If your student is enrolled at the Tech Campus, he/she may choose to attend. Transportation will NOT be provided.
- A quiet study hall for school work or independent reading at Grayslake Central.
- Edgenuity work for credit recovery students.

Students are strongly encouraged to take advantage of one of the off-campus opportunities on this day. Students and/or families are responsible for making arrangements for the college visit, job shadowing, or community service and provide the appropriate transportation. Please note that partaking in any of the above choices will be considered a school activity and will not negatively impact your student's attendance record. All seniors must commit to one of the options available to them for this day.
