Course Description: Driver Education is designed to prepare students with the skills, experience and the knowledge of rules for successful driving. Students will acquire experience and knowledge of the rules of the road through classroom textbooks, lectures, activities and videos. As students receive their permits, they will have the option to take the “behind the wheel” part of the class. They are not required to take this part. Prior to beginning “behind the wheel”, students must pay \$350.
