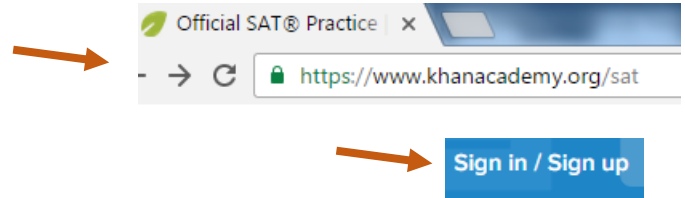


Creating Accounts for Khan Academy and College Board

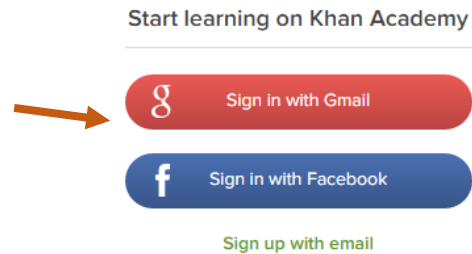
Steps 1-4 create your Khan Academy account.

1. Go to www.khanacademy.org/sat.



2. Click on "Sign in/Sign Up".

3. Select the "Sign in with Gmail" button.



4. Make sure you select your school account and choose "Allow".
(if your school account doesn't show up as an option select "Sign in to another account" and log in to google with your school email address and password.)
