

Graceland University Admissions and Advising Partnership (AAP)

Admissions and Advising Partnership (AAP) with Southwestern Community College

The Graceland University Admissions and Advising Partnership program (AAP) helps SWCC students smoothly transfer to Graceland. Students benefit from academic advising and a shared experience with the university prior to transferring. Graceland assists each student in planning their academic program at SWCC and Graceland to attain a B.A., B.S. or B.S.N. degree in a timely manner.

Benefits for Students

- Mentoring and academic advising from both institutions from the time the student is accepted into the program, which will assist in efficient progress toward a baccalaureate degree.
- Guaranteed admission to Graceland under the catalog of beginning enrollment at SWCC, provided all admissions requirements are met. Students entering Graceland with 56 semester hours of transfer credit will have junior status. Students entering Graceland with 48 hours of transfer credit will qualify for the alternative general education requirements.
- Option to choose graduation requirements from the Graceland academic catalog at the time of entrance to SWCC or at the time of transfer to Graceland, whichever is most advantageous for the student.
- Graceland student identification card, My Graceland account and e-mail address.
- Admission to athletic and cultural events at the same rate as Graceland students.
- Access to Graceland's career related programs, including career fairs and workshops.
- Use of the Graceland University library.
- Information about Graceland campus events and opportunities.
- Updated transcripts sent by SWCC to Graceland at no charge after each semester.

Eligibility Criteria for the AAP

- Students must be admitted at SWCC.
- Students who have completed community college coursework must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Applicant Steps for Acceptance

- After admission to SWCC, students meet with their SWCC academic advisor to discuss the AAP.
- Students complete an application for the AAP and have their SWCC advisor sign it.
- Students send the signed application to: Graceland University,
 Admissions Office, 1 University Place, Lamoni, IA 50140.
- Students arrange to have final official transcripts from their high school and each college attended sent to Graceland University Admissions. For students with a GED, supply a copy of the GED scores.
- Students should complete these steps as soon as possible after being admitted
 to SWCC and deciding to transfer to Graceland University. However, students
 may submit the AAP application at any time prior to admittance to Graceland.

Student Responsibilities while in the AAP

- Enroll at SWCC in a major suitable for transfer to a program at Graceland.
- Consult with SWCC and Graceland academic advisors, prior to acceptance into the AAP, to review courses completed and to consider a Graceland degree.
- Consult with a Graceland University advisor the first semester of enrollment in the AAP to create a transfer and graduation plan. Meet with Graceland advisor as appropriate in semesters prior to transfer.
- Meet with the SWCC advisor each semester before registration to select courses that will meet the requirements of the transfer plan.
- Consult with SWCC and Graceland advisors before changing an agreed-upon course schedule.
- Earn and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA (on a 4.0 scale) in all transferable coursework and meet degree program requirements.
- Submit a Graceland University Undergraduate Application for Admission, final official high school transcript, GED Scores (if applicable) and final official transcripts from SWCC and all other post-secondary schools in which previously enrolled.
- Agree to support the rules and regulations of Graceland University as specified in official publications. This includes refraining from using tobacco and possessing or using alcohol or drugs on campus or at Graceland sponsored activities.
