



## *Elmwood Park High School Registration Information Summer Academy 2017*

Elmwood Park High School students can earn credit towards graduation during the summer! Students can get ahead in their required classes or recover credits through APEX, an online learning platform. Using APEX, students work individually, with teacher monitoring, frequent check-ins, and instructional assistance as needed, all conducted by certified Elmwood Park High School staff.

**Class Offerings:** All core content and elective courses are available to students as long as they are continued offerings through APEX. Refer to the list on the back of this form. You can learn more about APEX online digital curriculum and read course descriptions at <https://www.apexlearning.com/>

**How Many:** A student can enroll in only one credit per Summer Academy and cannot take multiple classes at the same time. Courses listed on the APEX website as “One Semester” in length are 0.5 credits. Courses listed as “Two Semesters” in length are 1.0 credits.

**Class Times:** Students are expected to attend the Summer Academy from 8 AM - 12 PM Monday-Friday at the high school in the library. However, students using APEX digital curriculum will work at their own pace. When a student successfully completes the coursework, he/she is no longer required to attend class.

**Dates:** The Summer Academy begins on Monday, June 5, 2017 and ends Friday, July 14, 2017. Class will NOT meet on July 4.

### **Registration and Costs:**

- General Registration should be submitted to the Registrar’s Office at the high school by May 12, 2017.
- The cost for 1.0 credit is \$275 for in-district students and \$375 for students from outside the district.
- A minimum deposit of \$100 is due at the time of registration.
- Payment in full is required by June 5, 2017, which is the first day of class.
- If full payment has not been received by that date, the student will not be allowed to attend the Summer Academy.
- Late registration will be accepted between May 13 and June 1. (*A late registration fee may be assessed*)
- There are no refunds once the student has begun class.
