WHAT IS AN ACTIVE SHOOTER?

- * Department of Homeland Security defines an active shooter as an individual(s) actively engaged in killing or attempting to kill people in a confined and populated area; in most cases, active shooters use firearm(s) and there is no pattern or method to their selection of victims
- * Who it's not...
- ***** Who commits these acts???

WHY DO WE TRAIN FOR THIS?

* Simply Put,

Because incident is too many!!!

Soft Lockdown

Incidents that warrant Soft Lockdown:

- * Civil Disturbance in the area
- Gang activity
- Disruptive person/visitor
- Suspicious person in the area
- Police activity in the area
- * (important to know there may not be much information readily available)

× Soft Lockdown

Simply put: building a secure environment by locking down exterior perimeter access points of the building



× Soft Lockdown

What about the beginning or end of day??? Could you be affected???

× Hard Lockdown

Incidents that warrant Hard Lockdown:

- * Active Shooter
- * Someone who fails to check in
- Hostage incident
- Riot or gang fight
- x Kidnapping/Abduction
- Out of control person
- * Other life threatening event

* Hard Lockdown

COPING

WITH AN ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATION

- Be aware of your environment and any possible dangers
- Take note of the two nearest exits in any facility you visit
- If you are in an office, stay there and secure the door
- Attempt to take the active shooter down as a last resort

HOW TO RESPOND

WHEN AN ACTIVE SHOOTER IS IN YOUR VICINITY

1. RUN

- Have an escape route and plan in mind
- · Leave your belongings behind
- · Keep your hands visible

2. HIDE

- . Hide in an area out of the shooter's view
- Block entry to your hiding place and lock the doors
- Silence your cell phone and/or pager

3. FIGHT

- As a last resort and only when your life is in imminent danger
- · Attempt to incapacitate the shooter
- Act with physical aggression and throw items at the active shooter

PROFILE

OF AN ACTIVE SHOOTER

An active shooter is an individual actively engaged in killing or attempting to kill people in a confined and populated area, typically through the use of firearms.

CHARACTERISTICS

OF AN ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATION

- · Victims are selected at random
- The event is unpredictable and evolves quickly
- Law enforcement is usually required to end an active shooter situation



HOW TO RESPOND

WHEN LAW ENFORCEMENT ARRIVES

- · Remain calm and follow instructions
- Put down any items in your hands (i.e., bags, jackets)
- · Raise hands and spread fingers
- Keep hands visible at all times
- Avoid quick movements toward officers such as holding on to them for safety
- · Avoid pointing, screaming or yelling
- Do not stop to ask officers for help or direction when evacuating

INFORMATION

YOU SHOULD PROVIDE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OR 911 OPERATOR.

- · Location of the active shooter
- · Number of shooters
- Physical description of shooters
- Number and type of weapons held by shooters
- · Number of potential victims at the location



EVACUATION

Evacuation point – every school has one predetermined

* WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT???

* EVERY CHILD NEEDS DIRECTION AND TO BE ACCOUNTED FOR

THAT WAY

ANOTHER WA

REUNIFICATION POINT

* A predetermined location where all students, staff, and *family* can meet after situation is

under control



WHAT NOT TO DO AS PARENTS!

***** DO NOT GO TO THE INCIDENT LOCATION OR EVACUATION POINT!!!



***** WHY???

HOW DO FIRST RESPONDERS GET THERE?

* PARENT / GUARDIAN VEHICLES IN ROADWAY
WILL CAUSE CONGESTION THAT WILL PREVENT
POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL
FROM GETTING TO THE SCENE – THIS WILL
ONLY WORSEN THE SITUATION!!!

CAN WE PREVENT THIS?

- * Seek help immediately from the school, medical professionals and/or police department if any signs of activity causing concern are noticed.
- **×** For example: (not limited to)
- Violent drawings
- Obsession with prior active shooter / homicidal or suicidal incidents
- Web searches of homicidal, suicidal topics / incidents
- Comments referring to homicidal and/or suicidal tendencies

CAN WE PREVENT THIS?


