Opened for classes in 1954, EPHS now has an enrollment of approximately 950 students with over 70 certified faculty. With an average class size of 20:1, EPHS provides core, honors, Advanced Placement, and dual-credit academic programming for all students. We also support academic instruction for students with Special Education, English Language Learner, 504 plan, and all other special needs.
