How to Sign Up for BASEC

In-person registration for the 2020/2021 school year will be held at John Mills Elementary School on the following days:

- → March 19th: 6:00 8:00 pm
- → April 16th: 7:00 9:00 am
- → May 6th: 7:00 9:00 am & 6:00 8:00 pm

In the event more families register and BASEC has already hired sufficient staff based on pre-registration numbers, there will be a waitlist for the program.

Please know we will do everything we can to ensure your child starts as soon as possible.

To avoid being put on a waitlist, we strongly encourage you to attend one of the early registration days we have provided.






