# PRE-K SCHEDULE

Starting Tuesday, January 19th:

Students who opted for hybrid (in-person) learning will attend Pre-K during the morning session with their classroom teacher

Students who opted for remote will attend Pre-K in the afternoon session with their classroom teacher

AM session: 8:15-10:50

PM Session: 12:20-3:00

PreK continues to be a 5 days per week program

# EXPECTATIONS

Students attending in-person will:

- Wear a face covering for the duration of school
  - Please bring your own, we can provide extras
- Snack will be taken home.
  - Please make sure students eat before coming to school
- Students will enter and exit through **Door 5**
- Families will use the **Crisis Go** app to certify the health questions. [Parent University Video](#)
  - This is completed each morning before entering the building
- Any students arriving after 8:15 should go to the main office.
  - If you are in line waiting to be checked in, you can stay in line

# EXPECTATIONS

- Students will have access to handwashing station, wipes and hand sanitizer
- Please dress them in clothes you're comfortable getting dirty-
  - Students will be using paint, playdough, and get dirty
- Please dress for the weather
  - Students may go outside (no playground)
- Please dress students in items they may be able to easily remove (pants, shoes, etc..) to limit need for adult assistance
- For students coming in to school, please bring your Chromebook and leave in the backpack

# RELATED SERVICES

For students who receive speech therapy, occupational therapy, social work, and/or physical therapy:

- Your child will continue to receive these services.
- These services may be either in-person or remote while your child is in school.
- The service provider will let you know if there are changes to the schedule.

# LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

We will follow this schedule until at least March 8th (beginning of the 3rd trimester).

Families will be sent another survey in February asking for their preference for in-person or remote learning.

Once those results are received we will review and share out any changes in the schedule before March 8th.
