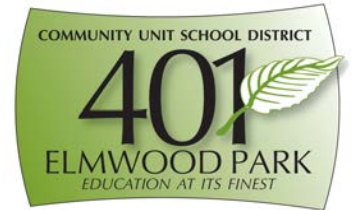

### Information & Policies



#### Dates and times

- Summer School classes begin June 14th and times will vary by program.
- Classes will also be held in-person and virtually based upon the program listed below.

## Available Programs

### Summer Apex (for Credit Recovery & Credit Advancement)

#### General Information

- To sign up for Summer Apex, please fill out the [Summer Apex Google Form](#).
- This Summer Academy program is for those students wishing to earn high school credit for a previously failed course or to take an additional high school course over the summer.
- A student may be enrolled in only one APEX course at a time. If a student is able to complete a course before the deadline, he/she can choose to take a second course if he/she pays the fee for a second course. All deadlines and attendance policies apply to the second course enrollment.
- All courses will be offered at the “Core” level and are listed as either one semester (0.5 credits) or two semesters (Full Year - 1.0 credit).
  - *\*The final decision regarding how an elective course will count towards graduation will be made by EPHS counselors and administration.*

#### Registration and Fees

- Priority registration will be given to seniors for graduation and credit deficient students. There is a student capacity limit of 100 students at a time for Apex. Any additional students will be placed on a waiting list and will be enrolled once other students complete their Apex courses.
- The cost for in-district students is \$50 for 0.5 credit courses and \$100 for 1.0 credit courses.
  - Out-of-district students: the cost is \$150 for 0.5 credit courses and \$300 for 1.0 credit courses.
  - Payment plans can be arranged via the Registrar's Office by June 11, 2021.
- Payment in full is required by June 14th, which is the first day of Summer School class, unless a payment plan has been approved by the Registrar's Office.
- If full payment has not been received by June 14th, the student will not be allowed to attend and may be subject to being placed on our waiting list.

- There are no refunds once the student has begun class.

## **Summer Driver's Education (Classroom and Behind the Wheel)**

### **General Information**

- To sign up, please fill out the [Summer Driver's Education Google Form](#).
- Our Summer Driver's Education program includes BOTH the classroom instruction and the Behind the Wheel driving instruction. Students must take BOTH in order to register.
- Summer Driver's Education is available for both EPHS students and Elmwood Park residents who do not attend EPHS.
- State Law requires that each student complete a minimum of 30 hours of classroom and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction. Any combination of absences and/or tardies which totals 3 will result in the student being removed from Driver Education and no refunds will be given.
- If the number of student applications exceeds the number of spots available for a course, a lottery drawing will be held to determine class rosters. Students may apply to participate in only one (1) Summer Learning Academy course. All duplicate entries of the same student will be deleted before the lottery drawing.

### **Registration and Fees**

- Students must be age 15 by June 1, 2021.
- You must pass a vision test before you can take your permit test.
- State law requires that all students must have passed their last eight classes to register.
- \$275.00 - Behind-the-Wheel fee (checks made payable to EPCUSD 401). \$20.00 - Permit fee charged by the Secretary of State-this must be made payable to the Secretary of State by check or money order. NO CASH.
- The fees must be paid in full with the Registrar's Office and no prior fees can be owed to the district.

## **EL Newcomers Camp (for English Language Learners)**

### **General Information**

- This camp is a summer program for high school students who are focused on strengthening their English grammar, spelling, vocabulary, writing, and speaking.
- Students will have the opportunity to engage in practical speaking both formally (academically) as well as socially (during field trips and walks out to Elmwood Park).
- Students will engage in building actual social constructs in a new country as an extension of what they learn theoretically in a classroom setting.
- Students will work on developing real life skills, such as filling out applications for work and college, filling out forms, planning trips via public transportation, etc.

### **Registration and Fees**

- Students must be enrolled or will be enrolled at EPHS in our English Language Learner/ESL program for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Cost for this program is \$100 and must be paid in full by June 14th in the Registrar's Office prior to the start of the camp.
  - Payment plans may be allowed by the Registrar's Office

- There are no refunds once the student has begun class.
