Timeline

- → <u>December 1</u>: Course Selection Information Parent Night
- → <u>February 1-11</u>: EPHS Counselors meet with all 8th Grade Elm students and select electives
- → February 14: Course Selections viewable in PowerSchool
- → <u>February 14-28</u>: Window for 8th Grade families to adjust Course Selections (*Please contact EPHS Counselor for any course change requests*)
- → March 1: All course selections finalized
- → <u>May-July:</u> Residency Verification & Registration
- → Early August: Freshman Orientation & Chromebook Distribution

Residency - <u>ALL Returning Students AND New Students MUST prove residency.</u> Registration information for the 2022-23 school year has not been updated yet, but when it is, it will be found here.


How Can You View Your Child's Course Selections?

- As a parent, if you have any questions, concerns or would like to request a change in a course selection - please reach out to your child's counselor





