Dr. Anderson and Dr. Wade presented the latest information concerning the budget for the recently approved Instructional Technology Plan. It is anticipated that there will be sufficient funds for the hiring of both PD technology coordinators based on the review of the current budget. The plan is to have eight half day training sessions for teachers. The new technology committee will start meeting this summer.
