By following the 3 R’s of Be Responsible, Be Respectful, Be Ready, all students will be prepared to face any academic or social challenge they may encounter. Quarterly goals are established for each classroom in earning compliments from other students and teachers. Celebrations for reaching those goals are held at the close of each quarter.
