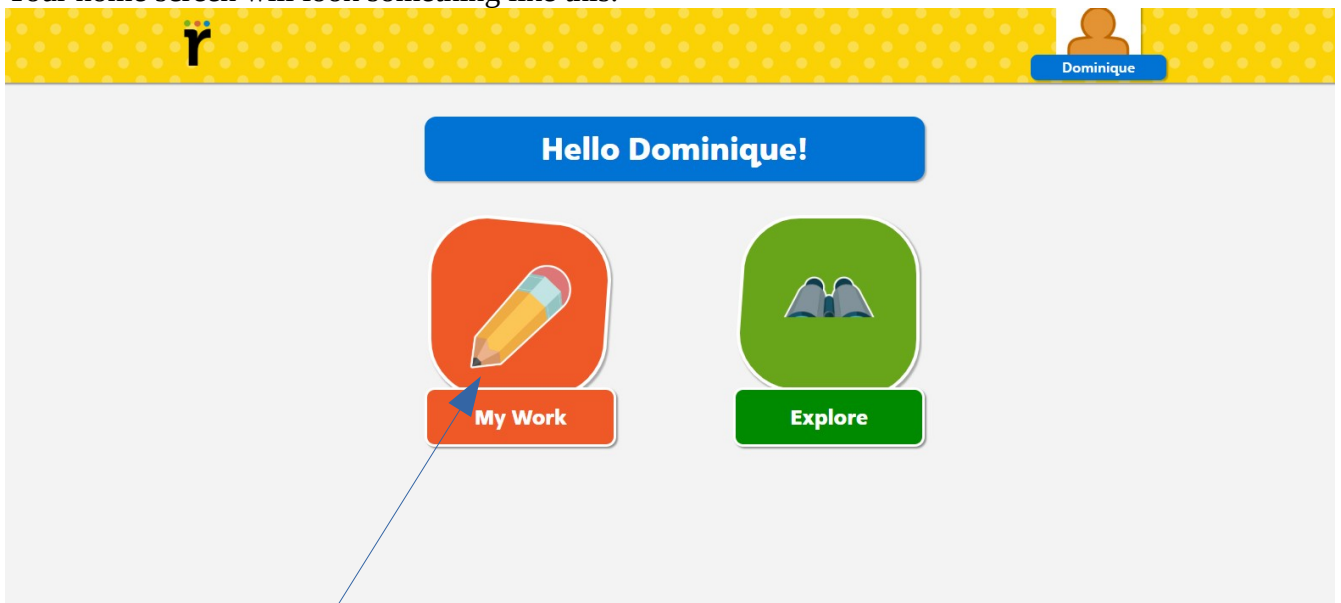

This screen should appear.



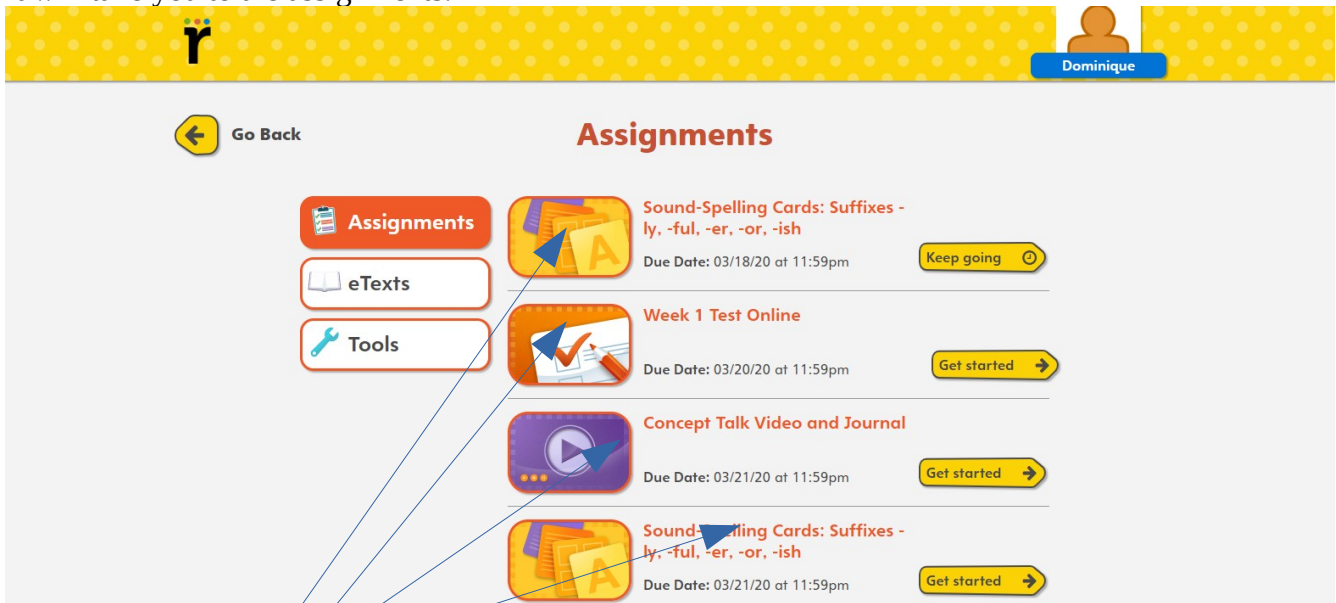
Type in your username and password and press “Sign In.”
