Summer Suggested Math Assignment:

Retain and grow your math fact fluency by earning three green lights a week on Reflex.

Our work with Reflex has been amazingly successful. The majority of this year's graduating 4th graders reached 100% fluency in addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division facts! You will be giving your child a great advantage in 4th grade and beyond if you ensure that Reflex becomes routine. We strongly recommend that parents create a Reflex Parent Reporting Account to monitor progress of math fact fluency using this link:
