## Saint James, Pray for Us



## Dear Friends in Christ,

Our patronal feast is a little over one week away, which means we have time for a novena to Saint James! The novena begins tomorrow and can be found <a href="here">here</a>. It will be prayed at the end of every Mass from July 16th through July 24th.

The novena prayer mentions three qualities of our patron. First, he had a "fervent and generous heart" -- fit for the Gospel, evangelizing, and martyrdom. Second, he was privileged to be with Jesus in two of His most important moments on earth: His Transfiguration on Mount Thabor and His agony in the garden. Third, James was willing to strive and do battle for the Kingdom of God. The name James is a derivative of Jacob, which means "he who supplants" -- a fighter! Indeed, we find in Saint James a sportive, zealous soul. So much so that our Lord nicknamed him and his brother John "Boanerges" -- *Sons of Thunder* (cf. Mk 3:17).

In light of these, let us offer the novena for these three intentions for the entire parish:

- 1. A conversion of heart, to make us more fervent and generous;
- 2. A greater intimacy with Christ, to come to know Him in each situation;
- 3. A willingness to enter into the battle for holiness, to strive for a deeper love of God and neighbor.
