Students will complete construction of the structure. They work about 180 minutes during the school day under the direction of Mr. Steve Masanz, a certified teacher from Kimberly High School.

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Past students of the Building Construction 2 course have completed projects in the community such as an archery platform and pavilion for the Village of Combined Locks, a two car garage for Christ the King Church, and a press box and concession stand at the J.R. Gerritts Middle School soccer field.
