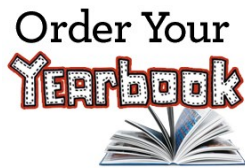
Pay for your student's registration and class fees online through Infinite Campus by accessing your parent portal. Why stand in long lines when you can pay from the comfort of your home? Don't have an Infinite Campus account or forgot your username or password?

You will be able to pay fees for all your students throughout the district at one time. You may also put money on their lunch account at the same time. Do it all in one easy step, anytime of day, at your convenience. Send your student on registration days to pick up their schedule, have their picture taken and purchase a parking permit (if applicable). Of course, we would also love to see you during registration if you would like to attend.

**Remember, during registration ONLY cash and checks will be accepted. All credit card payments must go through Infinite Campus.**



## Important Dates, Deadlines, and Pick-up Information

You can order a Yearbook online via Infinite Campus or when you pay dues at registration. The cost is \$60.

Students who ordered a 2016-17 yearbook can pick it up at registration on August 10 or August 15 or once school starts in Mrs. Yunk's room (1176). A family member or friend can pick up a yearbook if you are unable to.

Orders for 2017-18 yearbooks must be placed in the main office before Spring Break.

Class of 2017 graduates are welcome to stop by during registration to pick up their yearbooks as well or may pick them up in the high school office anytime after registration.

**Student ID Cards:** Students will need to carry their ID cards during the school day. Cards are used for:

- Access to school
- Checking out LMC materials including Chromebooks
- Free admission to most home athletic events
- Admission to school dances and special events

With 1600 students it is important all students have their card with them daily. Replacement cards are \$6.

CAPP Class Fees - Please note that CAPP fees are assessed by the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh. Student costs will be \$100.00 per credit making CAPP PreCalculus and CAPP Spanish class fees a total of \$500.00. Students eligible for free and reduced lunch would be responsible to pay \$45.00 per credit at a cost of \$225.00. These fees are due by the start of the class unless other arrangements have been made with the KHS office.

## How do I check my progress toward earning KHS Laude Honors?

A student or parent can check the number of quarters of indexed courses that apply toward our KHS Laude Honors by utilizing Infinite Campus. **Once the IC portal is activated for a student's 17-18 schedule...**

1. Log into Infinite Campus.
2. Select *Reports* from the menu on the left
3. Select *TS with both GPA's*
4. Determine if your *Weighted GPA w/ Bonus* is greater than or equal to absolute 3.4. If so, you are eligible to be considered for Laude Honors.
5. Find courses listed that are considered indexed courses. These typically include Honors, AP, CAPP and CLEP courses. Courses will be identified with a *Bonus Points* notation under the course listing.
6. Add up the number of quarters that have *Bonus Points: .02500* listed. For instance, Honors English 9 = 4 quarters earned. Note if the course is a **skinny** as it will show *Bonus Points: .01250*; therefore, each of these counts for half of a quarter. For example, four quarters of AP Human Geography S = 2 quarters earned.
7. Add additional quarters based on current term enrollment not saved to transcript that you plan to complete.
8. Check the sum of the quarters completed against the current cut-off values for Laude Honors.

Summa Cum Laude	28
Magna Cum Laude	20
Cum Laude	14

### **Family Move - Outside of the Kimberly Area School District**

When a family moves outside of the Kimberly Area School District, students may continue to attend the school where they are currently enrolled if they qualify for a Tuition Waiver (obtained from the district office). Students who qualify for a Tuition Waiver are entitled to continue their enrollment through the waiver period. However, they are required to apply for Open Enrollment during the next Open Enrollment application period if they want to remain in the Kimberly Area School District after the Tuition Waiver has expired.

### **Family Move - Within the Kimberly Area School District**

When a family move occurs within the Kimberly Area School District, students may continue to attend the school where they are currently enrolled even though their residence has changed to another Kimberly Area School District attendance area.

Parents who wish to have their student(s) remain in the same school after a move within the school district must complete the School Request Form located on the district website under Student & Parents>Enrollment>Attendance and return it to the district office Attn: Sara Vogel.
