KIMBERLY HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH APPRENTICESHIPS

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- The [Kimberly Area School District](http://www.kimberly.k12.wi.us) serves 5,205 students from 4K through 12th grade.
- There are currently 1,599 students in grades 9 through 12 at [Kimberly High School](http://www.kimberly.k12.wi.us).
- The mission of the Kimberly Area School District is, “To ensure that every student is given the opportunity to reach their potential through academics, the arts and co-curricular activities.”
- It is our goal that all students will [graduate with an attainable plan](#) to reach their goals.
- Youth Apprenticeship (YA) is an important opportunity for students to reach their potential.
- Through YA, students receive hands-on experience in real life business settings along with classroom instruction.
- Students also learn employability skills that will benefit them in any career they choose.
- At Kimberly High School, the number of students seeking Youth Apprenticeships and certifications while in high school has grown dramatically. There were 22 students who pursued Youth Apprenticeships and certification opportunities in the graduating Class of 2014. The Class of 2017 had 107 students pursue certifications and Youth Apprenticeships while still in high school. This included 8 students graduating from the Architectural, Construction and Engineering (ACE) Academy at the school and 21 students in other Youth Apprenticeship programs. *(See Figure 1 for more details)*
