KIMBERLY AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFERED \$180K IN STATE SAFETY GRANT FUNDING

Kimberly, Wis. – July 10, 2018 – The safety of students and staff within the <u>Kimberly Area School District</u> (KASD) is a top priority. Today, the District was notified that they are being offered \$180K toward the safety grant application they submitted to the state.

KASD continuously evaluates practices and facilities to make them safer. In addition to ongoing evaluation and training related to many aspects of school safety, the District recently had the Wisconsin School Safety

Coordinators Association (WSSCA) conduct a comprehensive assessment at all facilities for school safety.

Based on the recommendations from WSSCA and District leaders, the grant proposal was drafted to identify and prioritize projects that increase school safety.

The grant funds would provide for upgrades to the following safety features within the Kimberly Area School District:

- Security camera systems to increase video footage storage capacity, image quality and coverage.
- Entrances at the schools updated to a buzz-in system for visitors that uses a video intercom master station.
- Electronic key fobs for staff to access to District facilities.
- Upgrading the last of the school classrooms that have hollow core doors to solid core doors.

In total, 40 Wisconsin schools and districts were part of this round of grants awarded for a total of over \$2.8 million. The Department of Justice (DOJ) had \$100 million in grants available through the School Safety Initiative for Wisconsin school building improvements and staff training.
