To All Our Volunteers ~

We are so grateful for all who are able to volunteer at Westside both in the classroom and on field trips! Our job is not possible without the support and dedication of our families. Please be aware of the following guidelines for all parent volunteers:

- A current Background Check must be on file with the KASD. Please contact the Westside office to find out if your Background Check is up-to-date. The background check process takes approximately 2 weeks once we receive your completed paperwork.
- Teachers will notify/confirm with parents to schedule a time to volunteer in their classrooms.
- Please sign-in in the office and wear a visitor badge when you arrive at school for your assigned time.
- You may be volunteering primarily in the LMC workroom/office/outside of the classroom due to limited space, work accommodations, and student confidentiality rights.
- Teachers will notify/confirm with parents who will accompany the students on field trips. Occasionally, all parents who volunteer will not be able to attend a field trip for various reasons (space, background check status, etc.). Parents who chaperone are asked to pay their way for the field trip.

Again, we are so thankful for the support you give our staff and students when volunteering in any capacity for Westside Elementary!



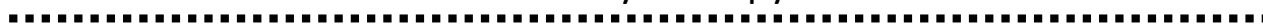
It's time to order your Westside Elementary Yearbook
