School Report Cards Released

As part of its assessment and accountability system, the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction creates a School Report Card for every publicly funded school in the state. The Report Cards are intended to help all schools and districts utilize data related to student achievement to monitor their performance and target their improvement efforts. On its Report Card, a school receives a score on a scale of 0 to 100 and one of five ratings based on that score. The ratings range from *Fails to Meet Expectations* to *Significantly Exceeds Expectations*. The school's score and rating are primarily based on the school's performance on statewide assessments in the 2017-18 school year.

Westside's Report Card score was 86.4 and this gave the school a rating of *Significantly Exceeds Expectations*. You can access Westside's Report Card along with those for all of the district's schools and a District Report Card on the DPI's website: <http://dpi.wi.gov/accountability/report-cards>

On the actual Report Card, parents can review the specific student performance information that is used to calculate the school's overall score. Keep in mind that these Report Cards are just one source of information about our school. 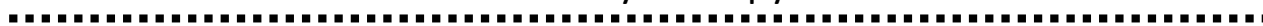
