#### **Current Needs**

#### 1,800 Youth in the Community Use Our Facilities

- · Co-curriculars have record participation
- · Indoor soccer requests are increasing
- Basketball requests cannot all be accommodated
- LaCrosse teams starting up in the District
- Over 200 gym requests denied

#### 1,500 KHS Students' Needs Have Changed

- 638 KHS students in one or more sports
- Changing focus of PE classes
- 31 classes of strength & lifetime fitness are currently scheduled (student driven)
- 60-100 after school strength participants
- 701 summer school strength participants
- Title IX

#### Maintain Reputation of Having the Best Facilities Available for Students

- Best facilities for Academics. Arts & Athletics
- Remain a destination District
- We are declining by over 50 students per year (estimated loss of 400 in next 5 years)

# Kimberly Area School District Building For Their Future

#### Finance Plan

- \$5.45 million project
- Will not increase taxes
- Booster Donations over \$500.000
- Cost of project paid through current District budget
- One-time cost, not recurring
- Low spending high achieving District (Per pupil spending \$1,000 below State average)

- · 4 Energy Star rated buildings
- Westside Elementary updated HVAC & new walls
- New 4K Center
- Special Education addition at KHS
- Special Education renovation at JRG
- LMC's at KHS and JRG have been updated
- Theatres updated/renovated at JRG and KHS
- Technology: added 1:1 technology in grades 5-8
- Welding: Expanded 2 times in three years
- ACE integrated construction program added
- \$2.5 million budgeted per year for Capital Improvement and Technology will continue
