PICTURE RETAKE INFORMATION FROM NETWORK PHOTOGRAPHY

RETAKE DAY – Tuesday, October 6th

STUDENTS WHO NEED TO BE PHOTOGRAPHED:

If students have not been photographed this school year, they will have their photograph taken on re-take day; even if you don't intend to purchase a photo package.

STUDENTS WHO WOULD LIKE RE-TAKE PHOTOS:

If you want a re-take of your student's original portrait, please return the original package in its entirety on re-take day. A replacement package will be printed and delivered to the school with your student's new image. If you did not purchase photos from the original picture day and want a re-take, please have the student's picture taken.

STUDENTS WHO WANT TO ORDER SCHOOL PICTURES FOR THE FIRST TIME:

If you would like to order school pictures for the first time, you can print and use the order form that is attached or obtain one from the school office. Just fill out the order form and send in your child's backpack on re-take day.

STUDENTS WHO DID NOT ORDER SCHOOL PICTURES AND WOULD LIKE TO ORDER AT A LATER TIME: If you do not order your student's portrait on re-take day, you will still be able to order online for the entire school year. Approximately 3 weeks after the portrait is taken your student will bring home a proof form with their own secure private gallery password. Online orders get mailed directly to your home and will include a shipping charge of \$4.50.

DELIVERY OF RE-TAKE PORTRAITS:

Re-take photos will be delivered to the school approximately three weeks after the re-take day.

RETAKES FOR ONLINE STUDENTS:

If your child is learning virtually this year, we still encourage you to have their picture taken. You may come to the school on the morning of retakes – October 6th, between the hours of **10:00-11:00 AM** to have their picture taken.

ACCESSING KASD LIBRARIES FROM HOME

All Kimberly Area School District libraries are open to both in-person students and those receiving online instruction.

Find us on the KASD website or at destinydiscover.com.



Research Access

KASD students have 24/7 access to research resources using their school's digital library catalog. Badgerlink, Webpath Express, PebbleGo, Gale, and other databases are available for each school with links on their school's library catalog page. Additional research assistance is available by contacting KASD library media specialist, Erin Wedemeier.



E-Books

Digital access to books will be a platform we will continue to grow throughout this process. For elementary students, Tumblebooks provides digital books, audiobooks, and interactive activities. Access this platform by clicking the link on the school's library catalog page.

Students in grades K-12 have access to a curated collection of e-books. K-6th graders can access these from their school's library catalog. Students in grades 7-12 can access e-books from their library website or by going directly to wsdlcwi.libraryreserve.com

Print Materials

Whether at home or at school, students can place holds on print books using the library catalog at destinydiscover.com. If a hold is placed by a student not currently receiving in-person instruction, the material will be left in the student's home school's vestibule for pickup. Books to be returned to the school library can also be placed in the vestibule area.

Holds will be filled when available, which could mean 24 hours to 24 days, if the book is currently in use by another student.

An email will be sent to the student to notify him/her of a ready hold.

Not able to log-in using Destiny Discover? Call your school's library to place a hold over the phone.






Log-in to Destiny Discover

1. Go to destinydiscover.com




- Choose location (Wisconsin)

- Click Go!


2. In the upper right hand corner, click “Log In”



3. If you are logged in to a KASD Google account, click Sign in with Google.

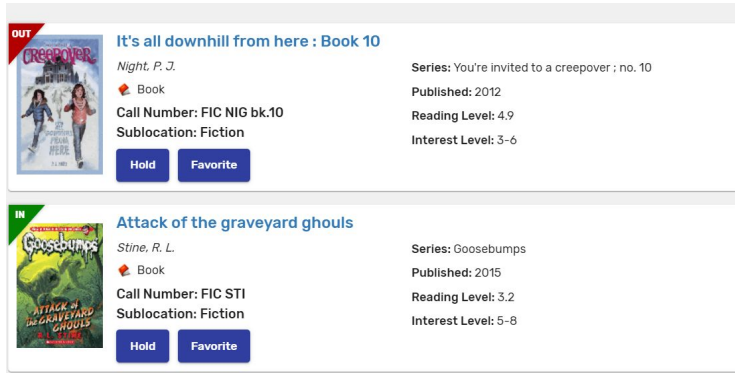


- a. If you are unable to log in with Google, use the student's lunch/library number in both the username and password boxes. (ask the student's teacher or school librarian for the lunch/library number)



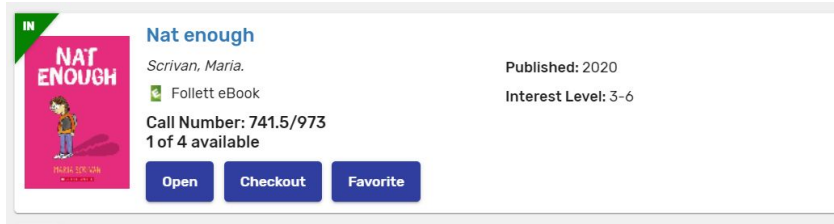
Reserving Materials in Destiny Discover

2. Once you've found a book you'd like to request, click on "Hold."

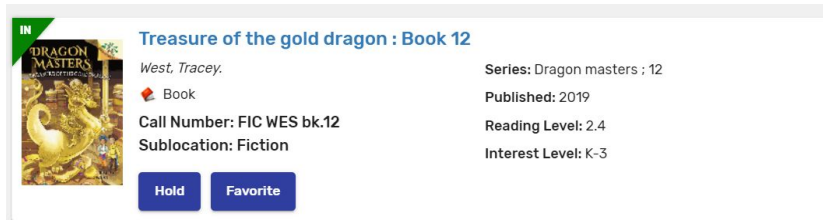


What e-books look like vs. print books

1. Ebooks (when available) - can be opened right away on a chromebook or other device

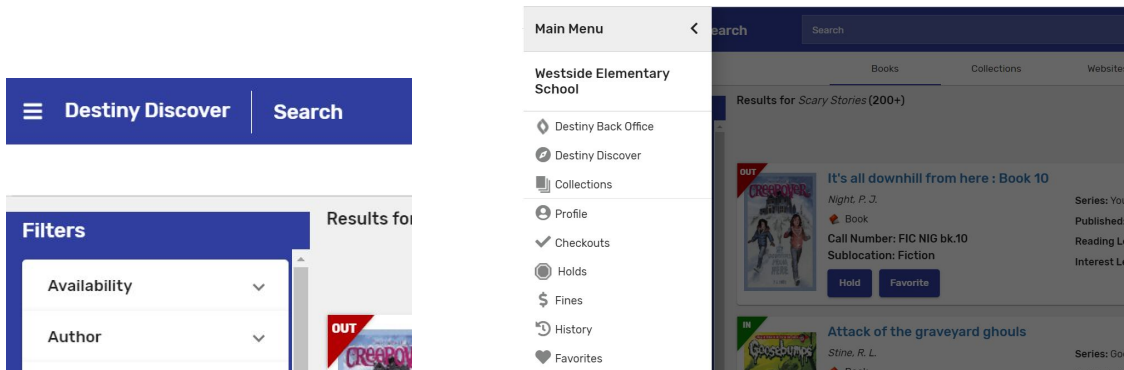


2. Print books (when available) - must be placed on hold. Book will be delivered ASAP.

STUDENT CLOSE CONTACT GUIDE

What is close contact? Your child is a “close contact” if ANY of the following situations happened to them while they spent time with a person with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

- ✓ Had direct physical contact with the person (e.g., hug, kiss, handshake).
- ✓ Were within 6 feet of the person for more than 15 minutes.
- ✓ Had contact with the person’s respiratory secretions (e.g., shared a drinking glass).
- ✓ Stayed overnight for at least one night in a household with the person.

SCENARIO 1

Someone in your household (my spouse, another child, etc.) is COVID-19 positive.

SCENARIO 2

My child's aunt is COVID-19 positive and my child ate with her yesterday. (My child was within 6 feet of her for more than 15 minutes.)

SCENARIO 3

My child's aunt is COVID-19 positive and my child spent time with her yesterday but kept a 6 foot distance.

Your child should stay/go home. You should notify the school office.

Watch for symptoms AND quarantine for 14 days from the last day of contact.

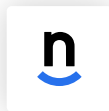

Download [Nutrislice](#) from your smartphone's app store.

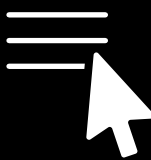

Type your school's URL into your computer's browser.


2. Get started.

Through the next few slides, continue to set up your account by providing the required details about you & your child. If you have more than 1 child, you can create profiles for each of them.

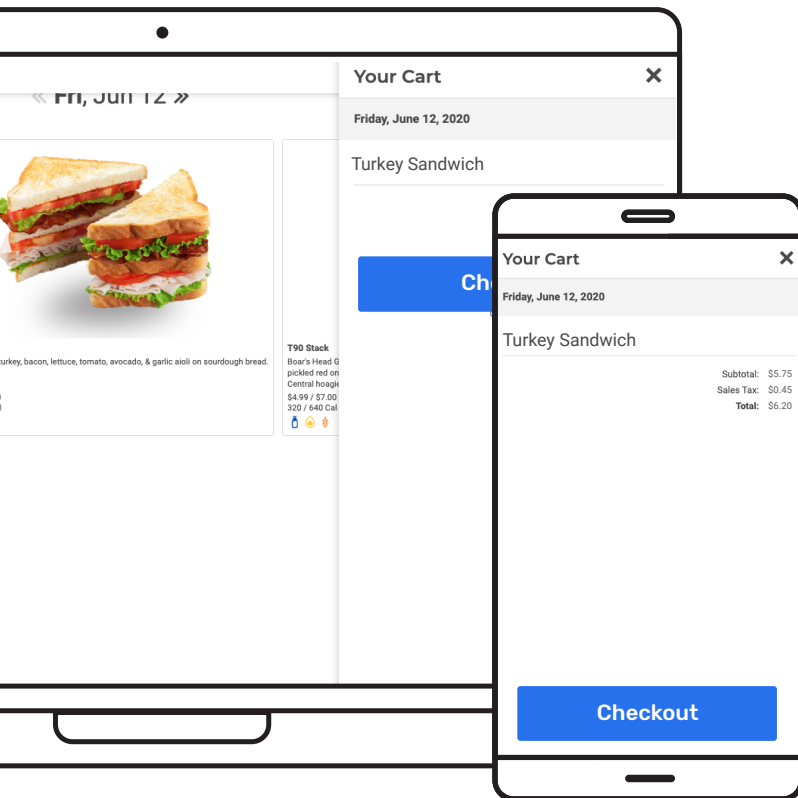

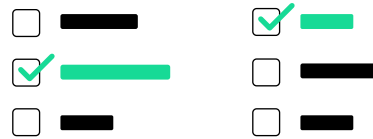

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS



IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

In a shelter



In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation



In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station



Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship

Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

Your eligible children have the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
 - Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
 - Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents.
 - Enroll in the local school; or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference.
- * If the school district believes that the school you select is not in the best interest of your children, then the district must provide you with a written explanation of its position and inform you of your right to appeal its decision.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
 - Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your children's needs.

If you believe your children may be eligible, contact the local liaison to find out what services and supports may be available. There also may be supports available for your preschool-age children.
