PENCIL applications are not acceptable. If you do NOT have access to a computer at home, the computers/typewriter in Student Services are available for your use.

For scholarships that need to be returned to Student Services, the ENTIRE scholarship application, including any letters of recommendation, needs to be returned to Student Services **one week BEFORE** the deadline date for processing. Deadlines are non-negotiable. Student Services will attach a transcript if needed.
