- ◆ Discussed the letter from Brian and Kris on L&L Tour Staff feedback – much time and discussion around rewording the letter to best reflect the situation, district staff feedback, the original purpose of L&L Tours

LIT Training for 2018-19:

- ◆ Date is Monday / August 27, 2018 / 1:00-4:00 p.m.
- ◆ Ideas include: some from last year's training, introduction/welcome, nuts & bolts that we didn't talk about – even after training this year there seemed to be a lot of confusion about LIT duties, purpose, scope of responsibilities so a lot of time was spent trying to figure it out on their own – discussion followed including the proposal the district provided to the association to help clarify and clean up the language around these issues – may not be settled but now have something to work with
- ◆ CIPP Review process – Brian explained how we do this and how it works - this is a good time for revisions with Indistar going away and the district has created a new template built to address EESA and Achievement Index pieces – good time to make CIPP reviews more meaningful – Sally McNair here today from the State WEA, explained about the new state changes and the new plan they're looking at – much discussion followed about how we make all this work together, be more effective, tie in, and what models will be available now – SEL & LAP dollar use grant requesting process...needs to be more integrated in the future – LIT...working well or not, funding...how it's being brought in and how it's being used – discussed school culture, teachers need to know of changes, what other SEL programs are available out there – per Sally...this fall is not the start of the 3 year plan it's more of a planning year – discussion followed about next fall and the changes in the CIPP plans – can each school decided their focus? – state law change requirement – we need to put this on hold until August as we develop plans for the year...if not a law any more we can change Board Policy – discussion about SEL and plans for that in the future...how we will be involved with that next year

- ◆ Discussed LIT Survey Results – much cause to celebrate! - pretty encouraging this year over last – results on the School Improvement Process and CIPP plans show that more people have awareness of what was going on at the building level – so the training and mid-year reflection we did was effective – people feel like they know what's going on better now – huge improvements this year particularly in communication – Mary/TURN expressed that these results are pretty impressive!
