One Covid-19 patient "presumptive positive" at Confluence Health

Wenatchee, WA, March 4, 2020 -

This evening we were notified a resident of North Central Washington, who is hospitalized at Central Washington Hospital, has tested presumptively positive for COVID-19. Confluence Health staff who have been involved in this patient's care since admission have been notified and will be monitored appropriately.

Four additional individuals are being tested and have been sent home for quarantine. Our thoughts are with all our patient's family, and to all our patients, providers, staff and their loved ones who have been affected by COVID-19 (Coronavirus) during this challenging time.

Confluence Health's Infection Control team continues to actively monitor the COVID-19 situation, both worldwide and in our local community.
