# No Child Left Inside: Learning Science Hands-On

WestSide sophomore Zoe Ebbert traveled to the Sagebrush Flat Wildlife Area in April to work with biologists to save the pygmy rabbit from extinction. It's all part of a WSU affiliated program called *No Child Left Inside*.

Zoe is in Stephen Niccum's science class at WestSide High School where No Child Left Inside takes students outside to learn about science first hand. Most recently Niccum's students are helping biologists save the pygmy rabbit through a breeding and reintroduction program where rabbits are kept in pens to breed and grow in the same area where they are later released.

"They're on a watch list because the population in Washington for pygmy rabbits is really low," explains student Brandon Petzold. "They're trying to breed them and bring them back up to the point where the species can live on and thrive by themselves."

The pygmy rabbit is the smallest rabbit in North America. It eats sagebrush, and digs its own burrows, the only rabbit to do so.

"I did not know that a pygmy rabbit buries their babies and feeds them once a day," says Zoe Ebbert. "I wouldn't have learned that from a book because it wouldn't have caught my attention. But when

we're in the field and catching them it's very interesting."

The students worked with biologists to capture, weigh, measure and tag the kitten-size rabbit in a safe manner. "They enjoy hands on," says Niccum.

Hana Butler of WSU's Chelan County Extension Office coordinates No Child Left Inside, bringing experts into the classroom and, along with Stephen Niccum, taking the kids into the field to work with the experts.

"Stephen Niccum really believes in what we're doing—getting the kids outside and engaged to earn science credit," says Butler. "One day a week I come into the classroom and teach a concept and bring in speakers. We do one to two field trips each month."

"We want to go outside and enjoy nature for what it is," says Petzold. "Sitting indoors is not the best way to learn about nature."

"We've worked with Bob Bauer of Chelan County PUD, biologist Jon Gallie with Fish and Wildlife, and Hanne Beener with Chelan/Douglas Land Trust," says Niccum. "The kids are involved and connected with the community making a difference and learning things at the same time." "The pygmy rabbit has helped the kids feel they're connected to something bigger," says Hana Butler. Who would have thought that the smallest rabbit in North America would have such a huge impact on kids?

Science teacher STEPHEN NICCUM is battling stage IV metastatic melanoma. His students and colleagues have expressed their admiration for his courage and attitude.

STAR MEDINA, a senior in Niccum's science class: "The first week of chemo I thought he would stay home, but he's here every single day, smiling and pushing through. He is a fighter. It surprises me how much he dedicates so much time to his students. He's a big part of why I enjoy the WSU program."

WSU's HANA BUTLER: "Steve Niccum is my teacher and my mentor. He's become a very dear friend. He has the ability to have compassion for everybody else while he's fighting his own fight of health. I've learned so much from his dedication."

# **Back to School Information**

# Immunization Requirements 2014/2015

Washington State requires students to be fully immunized before they can attend school. Vaccine exemptions REQUIRE a physician's signature. The following vaccinations are REQUIRED for school attendance:

### Hepatitis B:

Grades K-12: 3 doses

DTaP/DT/Td/Tdap:

Grade K-12: Five doses (Four doses DTaP if last dose given on or after the 4th birthday).

Grades 6-12: One dose of Tdap required on or after 11 years of age.

Polio (IPV or OPV)

Grades K-12: Four doses (3 doses if 3rd dose given after 4th birthday).

MMR (Measles/Mumps/Rubella)

Grades K-12: Two doses given on or after the 1st birthday.

#### Varicella

Grades K-6: Two doses given on or after the 1st birthday or health care provider verification of disease.

Grades 7-12: Recommended, but not required.

Two additional vaccines are now available for children, but are not required for school attendance.

### 1. Meningococcal vaccine

Meningococcal disease is a rare but serious infection of the brain (meningitis) and blood caused by bacteria. Adolescents and young adults are most likely to get the disease, especially those who live in group settings. Talk with your child's doctor about whether your child should have the vaccine.

The disease can be prevented with good hygiene (i.e. hand-washing and covering sneezes) and not sharing items such as water bottles or lipgloss. For more information visit the state Department of Health website at www.doh.wa.gov/cfh/Immunize/meningococcal.htm .

### 2. Human Papillomavirus Virus (HPV)

HPV is a common virus which has many forms, all of which are spread through genital contact.
Gardasil is a vaccine that protects against four types of HPV which cause 70 percent of cervical cancers and 90 percent of genital warts. The CDC recommends routine vaccination with GARDASIL for preteen girls and boys ages 11 to 12, and for teens and young adults ages 13 through 26 who have not already been vaccinated.

### August High School Proficiency Exam (HSPE) Opportunity

Students in grades 10-12 during the 2013-2014 school year who have not yet met state assessment requirements for graduation in reading and writing should plan to take the August 2014 High School Proficiency Exam (HSPE).

Testing at Wenatchee High School Attendance is required on both days! Writing: August 12 and 13 -Reading: August 14

### Registration is Required

After June 2, students in grades 10-12 who have not yet passed either the writing or reading exams will be notified they have been registered for August 2014 HSPE. It is vital for students to take advantage of these test dates as the next opportunity to meet state graduation requirements for diploma is Spring 2015.

Other ways to meet graduation requirements for state assessment:

- Become eligible to complete a Collection of Evidence (COE) exam; students must attempt HSPE two times to become eligible to submit a COE exam. The August HSPE counts as one attempt.
- Students may also meet graduation requirements for assessment with a passing score on ACT or SAT.

### Students who have left high school

Students who want to work towards graduation are encouraged to take these assessments through age 21. Students should contact their last school's counseling office to get their State Student ID number before calling to preregister at (866) 400-9275. When registering, please share your email address and mobile telephone number in order to receive important updates during the summer!

Students should bring the following to August HSPE testing site each day:

- 1. Official school or government picture ID (required)
- 2. Spring HSPE Individual Score Reports (if available)
- 3. Pre-registration confirmations (if available)
  - 4. Bring a lunch and beverage.

Students must report to Wenatchee High School Auditorium by 8 a.m. All tests must be completed on the scheduled day in which they were begun. Testing ends at 3:00 p.m.

### **Choice Enrollment**

### **Applying For Choice**

Parents who want their child to attend a school other than their neighborhood school must do the following:

 Enroll their child/children in their neighborhood school.

Complete a Choice form and turn it into the District Office at 235 Sunset Avenue. The forms are available at each school or the District Office.

 Confirm with the district office that your choice application has been filled out correctly.

### Important Dates

Important information regarding Choice enrollment: Choice will be accepted between February 1st and June 1st for the following school year. Choice is limited to one request per academic year.

Approval is determined by several criteria, including:

- Whether space is available in the grade level, program or building in which the student desires to be enrolled
- Attendance/discipline history,
- Academic progress and
- Program availability

### Other Important Choice Information

Parents of Choice students are responsible for providing transportation to and from school.

Choice status can and will be revoked at any time if a student shows a pattern of attendance, discipline or academic problems.

The district tries to accommodate everyone's wishes, but can't guarantee Choice status until the number of students enrolled at each school is known.

Due to the fact that many residential area parents do not register their kindergarten student until just before school begins, kindergarten Choice enrollment is not typically decided until one week prior and up to one week after the start of school.

# Career and Technical Education

Wenatchee High School and WestSide High School offer a wide variety of Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses for students. These courses provide hands-on, project-based academic enhancement and skill training for many career or post-secondary training goals. Students will find their STEM connections, equivalency credits for core courses and community college credits among these course offerings. Most courses include a beginninglevel course as well as advanced options. See each high school's on-line Course Description booklet to find the total list of courses and to see if entrance requirements exist for these courses. CTE courses at Wenatchee High School are: Accounting, Early Childhood Development, Personal Choices, AP Computer Programming, Fashion & Textiles, Photography, Applied Math, Health Occupations, Power Mechanics, AutoCAD, Horticulture, Small Business Management, Biology, Housing & Interior Design, Sports Medicine, Business Computer Applications, Introduction to Business, Tech Lab, Computer Hardware Repair, Introduction to Personal Finance, Technical Writing, Computer Programming, Introduction to Physics/ Chemistry, Veterinary Science, Cross Age Tutor, Marketing, Vocational Graphics, DECA Store Management, Natural Resource Science, Web Design, Drafting, On Your Own, Welding, Graphic Design, Desktop Publishing, (Yearbook and Apple Leaf ) and Introduction to Engineering Design.

WestSide High offers these CTE classes: Commercial Art, Introduction to Business, Graphic Design, Life Skills, Information Technology, Service Learning, Intro to Art, Teen Parenting, and Jobs for Washing ton Graduates JWG. Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged

Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 is a federal program that insures that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.

The Wenatchee School
District has six schools that qualify for Title I funding: Columbia,
Lewis & Clark, Abraham Lincoln,
John Newbery, and Mission
View elementary schools. At the beginning of each school year the district must notify parents of children enrolled in schools receiving Title I Part A funds that they can request the following information regarding the instructional staff who work with their children:

- Whether or not the child's teacher has met state certification for the grades and/or subjects he or she is teaching;
- Whether or not the teacher is working with an emergency or conditional certificate where state certification criteria has been waived;
- The baccalaureate (BA) degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held, including field of discipline of the certificate or degree;
- Whether the child receives instructional services from a paraprofessional, and if so, his or her qualifications.

In addition, each Title I school is required to notify parents individually when their child has been assigned to or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet the highly qualified definition set by No Child Left Behind. ### Meals at School

School Breakfast and lunch are available at schools at the following cost: **School breakfast:** Grades K-5: \$1.25; Grades 6-12: \$1.40; Adults: \$2.00. **School lunches**: Grades K-5: \$ 2.25 (up from \$2.05); Grades 6-12: \$2.50, (up from \$2.30); Adults: \$3.25. All ages milk: 25¢

Additionally, a free and reduced-price meal program provides healthy and delicious breakfasts and lunches to children of low-income families. Eligibility is based on income and family size. Students who were eligible for free or reduced-price meals when school ended in 2014 will continue to receive meals at a free or reduced price through early October 2014, but a new application must be completed each year to be considered for a continuation of these benefits.

An application for the new school year will be mailed to your residence in September. Please fill it out and return it as soon as possible to your child's school, the Nutrition Services office or the District Office. Families with students who are new to the district or to the free and reduced price meals program can apply at any time. Applications are available at your child's school office, the District Office or the Food Services office at 1001 Circle Street. ### **Nutritional Assistance**

If your family is facing homelessness or housing problems special new rules make signing up for free school meals fast and easy. Free breakfast, lunch and after school snacks served through the National School Lunch and School Breakfast programs may be one way to make sure your child can grow and learn. These programs have special new rules that allow children and youth to quickly qualify for free school meals for families facing housing problems and homelessness. No documents or paperwork is required. The program serves children and youth in families with housing or economic problems, or natural disasters that have forced them to: live temporarily with another family; live in a motel, campground or car; live in an emergency, domestic violence or transitional shelter. Or children and youth on their own: living temporarily with another family; living in a motel, campground or car; living in an emergency, transitional or runaway shelter; or awaiting foster care placement due to similar situations previously mentioned. ### **Dress Policy**

The Wenatchee School
District's dress policy prohibits
students from wearing clothing that
has any associations to weapons,
drug use, gangs or violence in
any way. The following is a list of
clothing or clothing accessory items
that have been identified as gang
related or associated with violent
behavior by local law enforcement.
These items may not be worn to
school or to any school-related
events:

- Playerz 69 (term for a gang member)
- Playboys/Playgirls (in words or the bunny logo)
- Oakland/LA Raiders (gang logo)
- Dallas Cowboys (especially blue)
- 5-pointed star or E. Smith (gang logo)
- Los Angeles Dodgers (gang logo)
- Old English or similar script on any clothing (gang related)
- Number "13" or "14" on jerseys or belt buckles (gang identifier)
- Pictures or graphics of hands showing "sign language" of letters or numbers
- "Smile Now/Cry Later" (in words or theatrical masks gang slogan)
- Clothing with "ICP", "Insane Clown Posse", or any graphics of "Hatchet Man" representing "Insane Clown Posse" (gang and violence related)
- Bandanas or head wraps (especially blue or red, (gang colors)) except those pre-approved by administration for religious reasons
- Belts that have a long, hanging end, or with weapon, drug or gang related markings or symbols on the buckle or along the belt.
- Necklaces, bracelets or rings that contain sharp or pointed spikes or any other attachments that could be used as a weapon (spiked collars, bracelets and rings)
- Eight-ball symbols (drug and gang related)
- Marijuana leaf or any other drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Charms or jewelry depicting any kind of weapons, drug or drug paraphernalia, usually seen on necklaces or ear rings
- Rosary Beads, the church has told us that Rosary Beads are not considered jewelry and should not be worn around the neck like a necklace. Rosary Beads have been associated with gangs nation-wide.

**Arrive at bus stops:** Please have students to the bus stop 5 minutes prior to the scheduled pick up time. Routes and times are subject to change as bus loads and service area may need adjusting once school has started to balance bus loads.

Special needs: Special needs students must preregister with the special needs department prior to riding the buses. Students will receive door to door service wherever feasible. Many specific rules and policies govern the ridership on our special needs buses. Parents will be notified of these regulations once registered.

Basic Ed Students: Students do not need to preregister, but they must use the assigned school bus stop closest to their residence. A list of all students and their contact information will be compiled in the fall of students riding on each of the buses.

**STUDENT TRANSPORTATION has** the best safety record for any of the ground-based passenger transportation methods.

WENATCHEE SCHOOL DISTRICT takes great pride in providing the safest form of transportation and service to our community's children.

Scheduled Buses: Know the number of your child's bus and the name of the driver. Be aware that children may ride buses with different numbers in the morning and afternoon. The location of their bus stops in the morning and the afternoon also may be slightly different, so check the schedules to be sure you know where your children are picked up and dropped off.

**Bus Passes:** Students (all ages) are only dropped off at their regularly assigned bus stops. They must have a parent note to obtain a bus pass to

get off at a different stop location. Each school office will write the pass allowing your child to get off at a different stop. Remind your student to arrange for the pass with the school office BEFORE the end of the day.

**Prohibited items:** State law prohibits certain items on school buses, including all forms of animal life (except Seeing Eye dogs), firearms, weapons, breakable containers (glass) latex balloons, flammables, perfumes and aerosol cans. Long boards are NOT permitted on school buses. Skateboards and scooters MUST be completely secured and encased in a backpack. Key chains attached to backpacks and clothing pose a real safety concern, as they can become tangled in the handrails or step-well area of the bus, causing students to trip. Backpacks and musical instruments should be small carry-on types that can sit on the child's lap or between their legs on the floor. While loading/unloading the buses any blue-tooth, head phones or ear pieces that could obstruct hearing are prohibited.

**Lost items:** If something is left behind, drivers normally keep it on the bus so they can return it the next day. You are welcome to call the Transportation office (662-6168) to help locate the lost article or search the lost

and found.

Bus Stop Laws: Stop for flashing RED. School buses soon will be on the road again, and the WSD Transportation Department reminds all motorists to follow school bus safety procedures:

Motorists must stop when a bus displays its flashing red lights and a stop paddle.

When the overhead lights on a bus flash amber, it means the bus is preparing to stop. Motorists should use caution, but do not have to stop until they see the red lights and stop paddle.

Use extreme caution around school buses. Students are instructed to always look at the bus driver and wait for the signal to cross before they enter the street, but small children have trouble determining the speed or distance of a moving vehicle and may suddenly dart into traffic. Please drive with care around children and expect the unexpected.
