Student Identification Badge

The Wenatchee School District Board of Directors recognizes that the visual identification of employees and students in District facilities is an integral part of the process of promoting and enhancing a safe and secure school environment. Identification badges provide for easy and complete visual identification and verification of all individuals in the school setting and subsequently easy identification of individuals who are not authorized in school facilities.

All Wenatchee School District students are required to have a photograph taken. All middle and high schools students will be provided with a photo identification badge and are required to wear or carry their identification badge at all times while on District property. The badge must be displayed to any school official upon request. Cards may also be used for other administrative purposes such as, but not limited to, accessing meals in the cafeteria, checking out library materials, classroom attendance and riding District buses.
