

## **Security Cameras on School District Grounds, Property, or Bus**

The board authorizes the use of video surveillance on district property for the purpose of maintaining the health, welfare, and safety of staff, students, and visitors and to protect district equipment and facilities. The board authorizes video surveillance in common areas on district property and further authorizes the superintendent or designee to determine exact locations for cameras. The board further authorizes the superintendent or designee to install cameras to address specific incidents or needs. However, the district will not install cameras or use cameras in restrooms or locker rooms.

In general, only those individuals with legitimate administrative or educational purposes may be permitted to view the video recordings.

The Superintendent shall develop procedures regarding the use of security cameras.
