

# **Job Title: Delivery Driver - Nutrition Services**

**Job Summary:** The Delivery Driver for Food Services is responsible for delivering food and supplies for the district's Nutrition Services programs. This role involves transporting products to and from the warehouse to district buildings, ensuring all deliveries are on time, and maintaining vehicle cleanliness and safety standards. The Delivery Driver plays a vital role in supporting the district's mission by ensuring food and supplies are delivered safely and efficiently to meet the needs of students and staff.

## **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- **Delivery and Transport:** Safely and efficiently picks up and delivers food and supplies to all food service programs, ensuring timely deliveries.
- Product Handling: Receives, checks, and transfers food and supplies to the appropriate storage areas. Rotates stock as needed to ensure freshness and minimize waste.
- Money Transport: Safely picks up and transports substantial amounts of cash, following district procedures.
- **Vehicle Operation:** Operates delivery truck in a safe, courteous, and professional manner. Ensures compliance with traffic laws and vehicle safety standards.
- **Vehicle Maintenance:** Cleans and maintains the interior and exterior of the vehicle as needed. Promptly reports any vehicle or facility maintenance needs.
- **Sanitation Compliance:** Adheres to all sanitation regulations, including proper food handling, delivery, and storage as required by state law and district policy.
- **Safety:** Maintains a clean driving record. Conducts daily inspections of the delivery vehicle, equipment, and facilities to ensure compliance with established safety practices and standards.
- **Customer Service:** Maintains a flexible, cooperative attitude to assist teammates and resolve any issues that may arise, ensuring high customer satisfaction.
- **Communication:** Effectively communicates with supervisors, teammates, and others in a respectful and professional manner.
- **Food Ordering Support:** Assists kitchen managers by notifying them of low product levels and ensuring food and supplies are ordered in a timely manner.
- Other Duties: Assists with other tasks as needed to ensure smooth and efficient operations of the food service department, including attending mandatory meetings.

- **Physical Demands:** Prolonged standing, bending, stooping, reaching, lifting, pushing, and pulling. Ability to lift and carry up to 70 pounds, up to 50 times per shift.

- **Environmental Conditions:** Frequently exposed to varying temperatures (cold, hot, humid), fumes, odors, and weather extremes.
- Noise Level: Moderate noise environment.

### **Education and Competencies:**

- **Licensing:** Must maintain a valid Washington State driver's license.
- Truck Operation: Ability to operate a delivery truck and hydraulic lift gate independently.
- **Physical Stamina:** Stands for up to 90% of the shift, frequently working in cold and hot, damp environments, and handling food products in varying conditions.
- **Skills:** Strong reading and writing skills are required. Ability to read and follow delivery schedules and safety procedures.
