Grade Level	End of Course Exam (EOC)
Grade 9-10 Algebra	EOC Algebra exam, required
Grade 9-10 Geometry	EOC Geometry exam, required
Grade 9-10 student enrolled in a math class BEYOND Algebra or Geometry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Makeup #1 (Algebra 1 equivalent) required • Strongly recommend to also take Makeup #2 this spring, but may be taken in January 2012.
Grade 10 student enrolled in a class lower than Algebra	Makeup #1 (Algebra 1 equivalent) required.
Grade 11 students who have not yet met standard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If enrolled in Algebra, takes EOC • If enrolled in Geometry, takes EOC and should take Makeup #1; must earn two math credits after grade 10 if standard is not met.
Grade 12 students who have not yet met standard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In Geometry, takes EOC, should take Makeup #1 • In Algebra, takes EOC • Required to earn 2 math credits after 10th grade. If math standard is met (along with reading, writing) student earns a Certificate of Academic Achievement.

11th and 12th grade	2011 2012 and 12th grade with earlier graduation years.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must pass HSPE reading and writing tests (or approved Options). • Must have taken HSPE or WASL math at least once; if not passed, then must earn 2 math credits after 10th grade. • Students with IEPs have additional options. • (There is no science requirement)
9th and 10th grade	2013 2014	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must pass HSPE reading and writing tests (or approved options). • Must pass Algebra and Geometry EOC exams (or both Makeup exams, or approved options) <i>subject to legislative change</i>. • Must pass HSPE science test (or options yet to be determined). • Student with IEPs have additional options.
