WAC 392-172-122 Definition and eligibility criteria for orthopedically impaired.

Students who are orthopedically impaired are those who lack normal function of muscles, joints or bones due to congenital anomaly, disease or permanent injury, and such conditions adversely affects educational performance **and** require specially designed instruction.

All students being considered for eligibility for special education and any necessary related services under this category shall be evaluated in all areas of suspected disability and in accordance with the procedures in WAC 392-172-106 through 392-172-111.
